The foregoing assignment includes all rights (a) to register or apply in all countries and regions for patents, utility models, design registrations and like rights of exclusion and for inventors' certificates for the Assigned Patents; (b) to prosecute, maintain and defend the Assigned Patents before any public or private agency, office or registrar including by filing divisions, substitutes, extensions and all other applications and post issue proceedings included in the Assigned Patents; (c) to claim priority based on the filing dates of any of the Assigned Patents, including under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the Patent Cooperation Treaty, the European Patent Convention, the Paris Convention, and all other treaties of like purposes; (d) in and to all causes of action, remedies and other enforcement rights relating to the Assigned Patents including the right to initiate and maintain legal proceedings in respect of any past, present or future infringements thereof and to seek and recover damages or other compensation in respect of such infringements and obtain equitable relief, including injunctive relief, in respect of such infringements, and the right to fully and entirely stand in the place of Assignor in all matters related to the Assigned Patents; and (e) to practice each and every invention claimed by any of the Assigned Patents, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee for its own use and benefit, and for the benefit of its successors, assigns, and legal representatives.

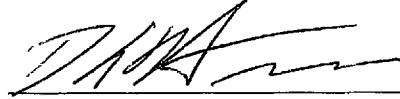

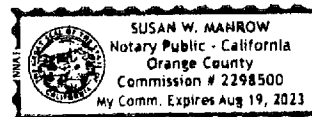
