ASSIGNMENT

 - d. all applications for patent which have been or may hereafter be filed for the improvements in any country, countries, or regions foreign to, or international offices with jurisdiction beyond, the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof; and

- e. all rights of action, powers and benefits accrued thereto, including the right to sue for and/or initiate any proceeding to collect damages and payments for past or future infringements of any of the foregoing.

2. Authorization and Request. Assignors hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents on applications, to issue all Letters Patent for the improvements to the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.


3. Assignors' Representations and Warranties. Assignors hereby represent and warrant that:






