ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment is granted by Pulse Innovation LLC, a Minnesota corporation having an address at 33 5th Avenue NW, Suite 800, New Brighton, MN 55112 (hereinafter "Pulse") to Acorn Cardiovascular, Inc., a Minnesota corporation having an address at 601 Campus Drive, St. Paul, MN 55112 (hereinafter "Acorn").

WHEREAS, Pulse was engaged and paid by Acorn to assist Acorn in the development of certain technology relating to cardiac support devices and associated delivery tools;

WHEREAS, the product development activity resulted in inventions that are the subject of United States Patent Application Serial No. 11/487,953, filed July 17, 2006, entitled Cardiac Support Device Delivery Tool With Release Mechanism (hereinafter the "Patent Application");

WHEREAS, employees of Pulse that participated in the product development activity are identified as inventors on the Patent Application, and Pulse may have certain rights to the Patent Application though its employment of the inventors; and

WHEREAS, Acorn desires to acquire, and Pulse desires to assign, any and all rights that Pulse may have to the Patent Application and related invention.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Pulse agrees as follows:

1. Assignment. Pulse hereby assigns, transfers and conveys to Acorn any and all of Pulse's right, title and interest throughout the world in and to said Patent Application, the underlying inventions described therein, and any and all Letters Patent whether U.S. or foreign that are or may be granted therefrom including without limitation any extensions, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues and renewals thereof, or other equivalents thereof (collectively, the "Assigned Invention and Patent Rights"), and further, all rights and privileges pertaining to the Assigned Invention and Patent Rights, including without limitation, the right, if any, to sue or bring other actions for past, present and future infringement thereof.

2. Further Assignment. Pulse further assigns to and empowers Acorn, its successors, assigns or nominees, all rights to make applications for patents or other forms of protection for said inventions and to prosecute such applications and said Patent Application, as well as to claim and receive the benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it, and the right to invoke and claim such right of priority without further written or oral authorization.
