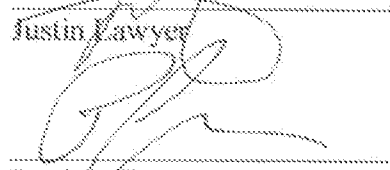
covenants that it conveys the entire interest herein assigned and that it has not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict herewith.

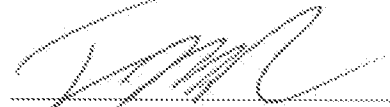

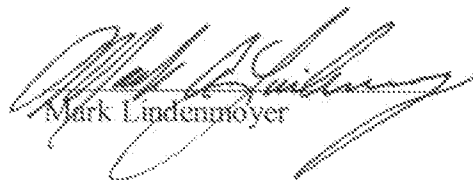
