PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 21st day of Jun, 2019, by and between Christopher J. Harder, Dave McMullin, Eric Blondsael, and Kien Vu, all of 3 Regina St N Suite A, Waterloo, ON, N2J 2Z7, Canada (the "Assignors"), and ExVivo Labs Inc. 
