PATENT ASSIGNMENT

THIS PATENT ASSIGNMENT (this "*Assignment*") dated as of December 22, 2021 (the "*Effective Date*"), is made by and between John A. Iafrate, an individual residing in Apopka, Florida (*Assignor*), and Conn-Weld Industries, LLC, a Delaware corporation (*Assignee*).

A. WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee are parties to that certain IP Assets Purchase Agreement, dated as of December 22, 2021 (the "*Agreement*"), pursuant to which Assignor has agreed to sell and Assignee has agreed to purchase the "Purchased Assets" as defined in the Agreement;

B. WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the United States Patent Number 9,662,655, entitled System and Method to Minimize Fine Material Produced During Crushing of Frangible Material, including all applications, reissues, reexaminations, extensions, improvements, divisions, continuations (in whole or in part) or equivalents or counterparts of any of, or related to the foregoing (the "*Patent*"); and

C. WHEREAS, Assignee, at its request and direction, wishes to acquire and Assignor wishes to assign all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration (including the premises and covenants set forth in the Agreement), the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Assignor hereby irrevocably sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent for Assignee's own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this assignment and sale had not been made, together with all income, royalties, damages or payments due or payable as of the Effective Date or thereafter related to any of the foregoing, including, without limitation, all claims for damages by reason of past, present or future infringement or other unauthorized use of the Patent, with the right to sue for and collect the same for Assignee's own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

2. Assignor authorizes and requests the Under Secretary of Commerce for Intellectual Property and Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office and any other similar government authority to record Assignee as owner of the Patent and issue any and all divisional and continuation patents, claiming priority to the Patent, issued thereon to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the same, for the sole use and enjoyment of Assignee and its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

3. This Agreement shall be construed under the laws of the State of Delaware. This Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
