ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I hereby sell, assign, transfer, and set over to Assignee, together with its successors and assigns, my entire right, title, and interest in and to: (1) the Inventions; (2) the Application; (3) any United States patent that may issue from the Application; (4) any United States or foreign patent applications or patents related to the Application through a claim of priority, including, for example, any divisions, substitutions, continuations, or continuations-in-part of the Application or a patent application related to the Application through a claim of priority, and any reissues, reexaminations, renewals, and extensions of any patents issuing from the Application or a patent application related to the Application through a claim of priority; and (5) my right to sue

for past, present, and future infringement, including my right to collect for damages from past infringement.

REPRESENTATIONS. I hereby represent and warrant that I have full right to convey the entire interest assigned by this Assignment Agreement, and that I have not entered any agreement which would conflict with this Assignment Agreement.

COVENANTS. I hereby covenant that: (1) I will not enter any agreement that will conflict with this Assignment Agreement; (2) I will fully cooperate with Assignee to secure or aid issuance of or maintain once issued any United States or foreign patents that issue from the Application and from any United States or foreign patent applications related to the Application through a claim of priority, by, for example, timely providing Assignee with facts known to me respecting the Inventions, timely executing papers for the Assignee to submit to the United States Patent and Trademark Office or to a foreign patent office, and timely providing oral or written testimony to the United States Patent and Trademark Office or to a foreign patent office; and (3) I will fully cooperate with Assignee to enforce or defend in litigation any United States or foreign patents that issue from the Application or from any United States or foreign patent applications related to the Application through a claim of priority, by, for example, timely providing Assignee with facts known to me respecting the Inventions, timely executing papers necessary to the litigation, and timely providing oral or written testimony necessary to the litigation.
