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CONDITIONAL ASSIGNMENT

An AGREEMENT made as of March 20th, 2013, by and between GENOSYS, a company having a post office address at 86 N. University Ave. Provo, UT 84601 (hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNOR), and PATE BAIRD, PLLC, a professional limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Utah and having a business address at 36 West Fireclay Ave. Murray, Utah 84107, (hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNEE);

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR has the entire right, title and interest in and to the inventions, patents, provisional patent applications, and patent applications listed in Exhibit A and other applications later filed hereafter, which may be found in files of client number 3460 of the law firm of Pate Baird, PLLC, 36 West Fireclay Ave., Murray, Utah 84107 (hereinafter collectively called the "Inventions");

WHEREAS, ASSIGNEE has extended credit to ASSIGNOR, which credit ASSIGNEE desires to secure by conditional assignment of the entire right, title and interest in said Inventions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and obligations set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

This CONDITIONAL ASSIGNMENT is an integrated Security Agreement entered into hereby concurrently with an ASSIGNMENT between ASSIGNOR and ASSIGNEE in consideration for preparation of the subject patent application and subsequent extension of credit granted to ASSIGNOR by ASSIGNEE prior to the execution of this Agreement, and in the event that ASSIGNOR does not pay to ASSIGNEE the Amount of \$ 50,000.00 on or before June 30, 2013 and an additional \$ 30,000.00 on or before Sept 30, 2013, then, upon failure of ASSIGNOR to timely make either of said payments, ASSIGNOR HEREBY ASSIGNS TO THE ASSIGNEE:

The entire right, title and interest in said Inventions in the above-identified United States patent applications and in all divisions, continuations and continuations-in-part of said applications, or reissues or extensions of Letters Patent or Patents granted thereon, and in all corresponding applications filed in countries foreign to the United States, and in all patents issuing thereon in the United States and Foreign countries.

The right to file foreign patent applications on said inventions in ASSIGNEE's name, wherever such right may be legally exercised, including the right to claim the benefits of the International Convention for such applications.

ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes and requests the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and such Patent Office officials in foreign countries as are duly authorized by their patent laws to issue patents, to issue any and all patents on said invention to the ASSIGNEE as the owner of the entire interest, for the sole use and benefit of the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives.

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees, without further consideration and without expense to

ASSIGNOR, to sign all lawful papers and to perform all other lawful acts that the ASSIGNEE may request of ASSIGNOR to make this ASSIGNMENT fully effective, including, by way of example but not of limitation, the following:


