## **PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT**

THIS PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT (“**Assignment**”) is made and entered into as of January 26, 2022 (“**Effective Date**”), by and between ClickFox, Inc., a Delaware corporation (“**Assignor**”), and Ignite Enterprise Software Solutions, Inc., a Delaware corporation, with a business address of 401 Congress Avenue, Suite 2650, Austin, Texas 78701 (“**Assignee**”).

**WHEREAS**, Assignor and Assignee, among others, are parties to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of January 26, 2022 (the “**Purchase Agreement**”);

**WHEREAS**, Assignor is the owner of the patents and provisional and non-provisional patent applications set forth in **Schedule A** attached hereto (collectively, the “**Patents**”); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Purchase Agreement, Assignor has agreed to sell, assign, transfer, convey and deliver to Assignee, among other things, all of Assignor’s right, title and interest in and to the Patents; and

**WHEREAS**, Assignee desires to acquire all of Assignor’s right, title and interest in the United States of America and in all other countries, to the Patents.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor and Assignee agree as follows.

**Assignment.** Assignor does hereby assign, transfer, and convey to Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and Assignee does hereby accept, the Assignor’s entire worldwide right, title, and interest (including, without limitation, all rights therein provided by international conventions and treaties) that may exist today and in the future in and to the following (collectively, the “**Assigned Patent Rights**”):

1. the Patents;
2. patents and patent applications, anywhere in the world, (a) to which any of the Patents directly or indirectly claims priority, or (b) that claim priority to any of the Patents;
3. continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, and continuing prosecution applications of any of the items listed in (1) or (2) of this Assignment;
4. reissues, reexaminations, renewals and extensions of any of the items listed in (1), (2) or (3) of this Assignment;
5. counterparts, in any non-U.S. jurisdiction or on file with any multi-national registration body, to any of the items listed in (1) through (4) of this Assignment, including without limitation, utility models, inventors’ certificates, industrial design protection and any other form of governmental grants or issuances for the protection of inventions, designs or discoveries;
6. inventions, invention disclosures, designs and discoveries described in the items listed in (1) through (5) of this Assignment (whether or not any patent issues) and improvements thereto;

7. patents that issue anywhere in the world from any of the items listed in (1) through (6) of this Assignment;
8. claims, causes of action at law and equity, and enforcement rights of any kind, whether currently pending, filed or otherwise, and whether known or unknown, under or arising from any of the items listed in (1) through (7) of this Assignment, including all rights to pursue and collect damages, costs, injunctive relief and other remedies for past, current or future infringement of the Patents and including rights afforded under 35 U.S.C. § 154(d);
9. royalties, income and other payments due as of the Effective Date and thereafter under or arising from any of the items listed in (1) through (8) of this Assignment; and
10. rights to apply in Assignee's name in any or all countries of the world for patents, certificates of invention, utility models, industrial design protection, design patent protection and other governmental grants or issuances of any kind related to any of the items listed in (1) through (10) of this Assignment.

The Assigned Patent Rights are for Assignee's exclusive use and enjoyment, and for the exclusive use and enjoyment of Assignee's successors, assigns and other legal representatives, to the full end of the term for which any patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this Assignment had not been made. Assignor agrees that no rights, title or interest in any of the Assigned Patent Rights are retained by Assignor.

**Authorization.** Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and the corresponding entity or agency in any other jurisdiction, to record Assignee as assignee and owner of the Patents and any other patents and patent applications included in the Assigned Patent Rights, and to issue any and all patents, utility models or other governmental grants or issuances pertaining to any of the Assigned Patent Rights in the name of Assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

**Further Assurances.** Assignor shall execute and deliver any instruments, and do and perform any other acts and things as may be reasonably necessary or desirable for effecting and evidencing the assignments contemplated by this Assignment and to record and perfect this Assignment, including without limitation, the execution, delivery of any and all affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney and other documentation.

**Representations and Warranties.** The Assigned Patent Rights are provided on an "AS IS, WHERE IS" BASIS, WITH ALL FAULTS, WITHOUT ANY WARRANTIES OR REPRESENTATIONS, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, OF ANY NATURE WHATSOEVER INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR CAUSE, other than such representations and warranties as are expressly set forth in the Purchase Agreement.

**Successors.** This Assignment shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties and their respective assigns and successors.

**Governing Law.** This Assignment shall be interpreted under the patent laws of the United States of America; but shall be litigated or prosecuted under the laws of Ireland, without regard to the conflict of law rules of any jurisdiction.

**Counterparts.** This Assignment may be signed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

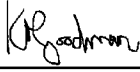
