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ASSIGNMENT

Subject to the terms and conditions set forth collectively in the Collaboration Agreement known as Research Contract RG63788 (the "Original Agreement") entered into between KACST and The Chancellor, Masters and Scholars of the University of Cambridge ("CU") of the Old Schools, Trinity Lane, Cambridge, CB2 1TN, UK, effective as of July 22, 2011, as amended on April 25, 2012, and on January 12, 2017; and in consideration of One U.S. Dollar (U.S. \$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration paid to Assignor by the Assignees, the receipt, adequacy, and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby sell, assign, transfer, and convey unto said Assignees jointly, and said Assignees' successors and assigns, Assignor's entire right, title, and interest in the U.S.A., including all rights of priority under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, in and to the Patents, and in and to all Letters Patent that may or shall be granted on patent applications or inventions within the Patents, or any parts thereof, or any divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, substitution, renewal, reissue or other applications based in whole or in part thereon, and all reissues, re-examinations and extensions thereof, in each case in the U.S.A., together with the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from the patent applications within the Patents; and further together with all claims for damages by reason of past, present or future infringement, with the right to sue for, and collect the same for the use of Assignees, Assignees' successors and assigns and all proceeds of the foregoing, including, without limitation, any claim by Assignor against third parties for, or any profits arising from, past, present, or future infringement of the Patents, the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignees and Assignees' successors and assigns as fully as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor had this Assignment not been made.

Assignor agrees, for itself and Assignor's executors, administrators, and successors in interest, at Assignor's expense, to execute all applications, amended specifications, deeds or other instruments, and to do all acts necessary or proper to secure the grant to Assignees jointly of said Letters Patent on said patent applications within said Patents, with specifications and claims in such form as shall be approved by the counsel(s) of Assignees, and to vest and confirm in Assignees and Assignees' successors and assigns the legal title to all of said Patents.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States to issue any such patents on any such applications within the Patents to the Assignees, and Assignees' successors, legal representatives and assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by Assignor had this Assignment not been made.
