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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Intellectual Property Assignment Agreement ("IP Assignment"), dated as of 4/14/22 2022 (the "Effective Date"), is made by Anne E. Mahoney ("Assignor"), in favor of Arthro-Positioning Systems LLC, a Georgia limited liability company ("Assignee"), each a "Party," and collectively the "Parties."

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers, and assigns to Assignee all of her right, title, and interest in and to the following (the "Assigned IP"):

(b) any improvements to the Patent, and any and all patent(s) resulting therefrom, as well as the right to claim priority to the Patent and related patent(s) and patent application(s);

(c) the trademark set forth on Schedule 1 hereto, which is attached and herein incorporated by reference, and registrations and applications therefor throughout the world;

(d) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignor accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions, and otherwise throughout the world;

(e) any and all royalties, fees, income, payments, and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and

(f) any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on, or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present, and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach, or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.

2. No Prior Transfer or Assignment. Assignor represents and warrants that:

(a) it has not transferred, licensed, or assigned any interest in the Assigned IP to any other party; and

(b) it has not entered into any contract, assignment, or license conveying any right granted to Assignee hereunder, or entered into any contract assignment, or license that would conflict with this IP Assignment.

3. Recordation and Further Actions. Assignor hereby authorizes the Commissioner for Patents in the United States Patent and Trademark Office to record and register this IP Assignment upon request by Assignee. Following the date hereof, Assignor agrees to provide cooperation and assistance to

Assignee and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, including the execution and delivery of any affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney, or other documents, as may be necessary to effect, evidence, or perfect this IP Assignment to Assignee, or any assignee or successor thereto, such that Assignee may realize and fully enjoy all the rights assigned hereunder.


4. Counterparts. This IP Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this IP Assignment delivered by facsimile, e-mail, or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this IP Assignment.

5. Successors and Assigns. This IP Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
