RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN SPECIFIED PATENTS

This RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN SPECIFIED PATENTS (this “Release”), dated as of June 27, 2022 (the “Effective Date”), is made by BANK OF AMERICA, N.A., in its capacity as Administrative Agent (the “Agent”), in favor of the grantor party identified on the signature page hereto (the “Grantor”).

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, dated as of March 18, 2011, by and among the Agent, the Grantor and certain other parties thereto (as amended by the Amendment to Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, dated as of March 28, 2013, as further amended by the Second Amendment to Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, dated as of June 2, 2017, and as further as amended, amended and restated, or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Guarantee and Collateral Agreement”), the Grantor granted to the Agent, in its capacity as Administrative Agent for the benefit of the Secured Parties, a security interest in and to certain collateral;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, the applicable Grantors executed and delivered for recordal with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (i) a Grant of Security Interest in Patent Rights, dated March 18, 2011 (the “2011 Patent Security Agreement”), (ii) a Grant of Security Interest in Patent Rights, dated as of May 16, 2013 (the “2013 Patent Security Agreement”), (iii) a Grant of Security Interest in Patent Rights, dated as of March 13, 2019 (the “2019 Patent Security Agreement”), (iv) a Grant of Security Interest in Patent Rights, dated as of January 30, 2020 (the “2020 Patent Security Agreement”), and (v) a Grant of Security Interest in Patent Rights, dated as of January 24, 2022 (the “2022 Patent Security Agreement”), and together with the 2011 Patent Security Agreement, the 2013 Patent Security Agreement, the 2019 Patent Security Agreement and the 2020 Patent Security Agreement, the “Patent Security Agreements”;

WHEREAS, (i) the 2011 Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on April 21, 2011 at Reel/Frame 026165/0478, (ii) the 2013 Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on June 10, 2013 at Reel/Frame 030582/0194, (iii) the 2019 Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on March 14, 2019 at Reel/Frame 048604/0092, (iv) the 2020 Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on January 30, 2020 at Reel/Frame 051759/0652 and (v) the 2022 Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on January 24, 2022 at Reel/Frame 058886/0438;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, the Agent and the Prior Agent (as defined in the Notices of Succession of Agency) executed and delivered for recordal with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (i) a Notice of Succession of Agency, dated as of February 22, 2019 (the “First Notice of Succession of Agency”) and (ii) a Notice of Succession of Agency, dated as of February 22, 2019 (the “Second Notice of Succession of Agency”), and together with the First Notice of Succession of Agency, the “Notices of Succession of Agency”;

WHEREAS, (i) the First Notice of Succession of Agency was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on February 25, 2019 at Reel/Frame 048429/0169 and (ii) the Second Notice of Succession of Agency was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on February 25, 2019 at Reel/Frame 048429/0264;

WHEREAS, in reliance of the Grantor’s representations and warranties concerning the transactions referenced in that certain Confirmation of Partial Release, dated as of the date hereof, the Agent has agreed to release, discharge, terminate and cancel its security interest in certain specified collateral;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Agent hereby agrees as follows:

1. Defined Terms. All capitalized terms used, but not otherwise defined herein, shall have the respective meanings ascribed in or otherwise referenced in the Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, the Patent Security Agreements or the Notices of Succession of Agency, as applicable.

2. Release of Specified Collateral. The Agent, without representation or warranty of any kind, hereby releases, discharges, terminates and cancels all of its security interest in and to the patents and patent applications set forth in Schedule I attached hereto (the “Released Patent Collateral”), arising under the Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, the Patent Security Agreements and the Notices of Succession of Agency. If and to the extent that the Agent has acquired any right, title or interest in and to the Released Patent Collateral, the Agent, without representation or warranty of any kind, hereby re-transfers, re-conveys and re-assigns such right, title or interest to the Grantor.

3. Limitation. This Release is applicable only and solely with respect to the Released Patent Collateral and to no other collateral arising under the Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, the Patent Security Agreements or the Notices of Succession of Agency. The Agent retains all security interests, liens, rights, titles and interests pledged and granted to the Agent under the Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, the Patent Security Agreements and the Notices of Succession of Agency with respect to all such other collateral, and the Agent’s security interest, liens, rights, titles and interests in such other collateral shall not, and shall not be deemed to, be impaired, interrupted or otherwise modified in any respect by this Release.


4. Further Assurances. The Agent agrees to take all further actions, and provide to the Grantor and its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, all such cooperation and assistance (including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of any and all documents or other instruments), reasonably requested by the Grantor, at the Grantor’s sole cost and expense, to more fully and effectively effectuate the purposes of this Release.

5. Governing Law. This Release shall be governed exclusively under the laws of the State of New York, without regard to conflicts of law or choice of law principles.
