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PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT ("**Patent Assignment**"), dated as of July 31, 2022 (the "**Effective Date**"), is made by IconX, LLC, a limited liability company duly organized under the laws of the State of Kansas, and having its principal place of business at 13904 Lucille St., Overland Park KS 66221 ("**Assignor**"), in favor of Keith Jensen, an individual, having a residence address of 14620 Dearborn, Overland Park KS 66223 ("**Assignee**").

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged:

1. **Assignment.** Assignor does hereby irrevocably convey, transfer, and assign to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the following (collectively, the "**Patent Rights**"):

(a) US Patent No. 10,132,080, titled Insulated Concrete Panel Tie, and all issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations and renewals thereof;

(b) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignor accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions and otherwise throughout the world;

(c) any and all royalties, fees, income, payments and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and

(d) any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.

2. **Recordation and Further Actions.** Assignor hereby authorizes the Commissioner for Patents in the United States Patent and Trademark Office to record and register this Patent Assignment upon request by Assignee. Following the date hereof, Assignor shall take such steps and actions, and provide such cooperation and assistance to Assignee and its successors, assigns and legal representatives, including the execution and delivery of any affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney, or other documents, as may be necessary to effect, evidence or perfect the assignment of the Patent Rights to Assignee, or any assignee or successor thereto.

3. **Successors and Assigns.** This Patent Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

4. Governing Law. This Patent Assignment and any claim, controversy, dispute or cause of action (whether in contract, tort or otherwise) based upon, arising out of or relating to this Patent Assignment and the transactions contemplated hereby shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the State of Kansas, without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of Kansas or any other jurisdiction).

5. Counterparts. This Patent Assignment may be executed in two or more counterparts, and it is not necessary that signatures of all parties appear on the same counterpart, but such counterparts together will constitute a single binding agreement between and among all parties hereto. Counterparts may be executed by hand or by any electronic signature complying with the U.S. federal ESIGN Act of 2000 (the "ESIGN Act"). Executed counterparts may be delivered via facsimile, electronic mail or other similar transmission method, and any executed counterpart so delivered will be valid and effective for all purposes. No party will raise the use of any electronic signature that complies with the ESIGN Act (including www.docusign.com), or the use of a facsimile machine, electronic mail or other similar transmission method as a means to deliver a signature to this Patent Assignment or any amendment hereto as a defense to the formation or enforceability of a contract and each party forever waives any such defense.
