AND Assignor hereby does sell, assign, transfer, and convey to Assignee, its respective successors, legal representatives, and assigns **a joint claim** for damages and all remedies arising out of any violation of the rights assigned hereby that may have accrued prior to the date of assignment to Assignees, or may accrue hereafter, including, but not limited to, the right to sue for, collect, and retain damages for past infringements of said Letters Patent before or after issuance;

AND Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the appropriate governmental officials to issue any and all such United States or foreign Letters Patent under said invention, or resulting from any of said applications thereof, **to the Assignor and Assignee, as joint owners** of the right, title and interest in and to the same;

AND Assignor hereby represents, warrants and covenants that it has the full right to convey the interest herein assigned, that it has not executed and will not execute any instrument or assignment in conflict herewith, and that the rights assigned herein are not otherwise encumbered by any grant, license or right;

AND Assignor further covenants and agrees that Assignor will at any time upon request make, execute and deliver without further compensation, any and all other instruments in writing, including further applications, papers, affidavits, power of attorney, assignments, and other documents, and do all

lawful acts and things, which, in the opinion of counsel for said Assignee, its respective successors and assigns, may in any country be required or necessary more effectively to secure to and vest in said Assignee, its successors and assigns the **joint right**, title and interest in and to said Invention and Rights hereby assigned, transferred and conveyed, and that Assignor will sign any applications for reissue, division, continuation, continuation-in-part, renewal, substitute or extension of said application for Letters Patent or any resulting Letters Patent;

AND Assignor further covenants and agrees that Assignor will at any time upon request communicate to the Assignee, its respective successor, assign or other legal representatives any facts relating to the aforesaid invention known to it, and will testify as to the same in any interference, litigation, mediation, arbitration or other proceeding when requested to do so.
