**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR AUTHORITY TO SELL PROPERTY OF THE  
ESTATE FREE AND CLEAR OF LIENS AND OTHER INTERESTS (DOC. 47)**

This case came before the Court on Monday, April 21, 2022, after adequate notice was given, for a hearing on the *Motion for Authority to Sell Property of the Estate Free and Clear of Liens and Other Interests* (the “Motion to Sell”) filed by Chapter 7 Trustee, Thomas E. Reynolds (the “Trustee”).<sup>1</sup> Appearances were noted on the record. The Motion to Sell concerns the Estate’s interests in certain patents and patent applications (the “Property”<sup>2</sup>), and the proposed purchaser is Global Bamboo Technologies, Inc. (“Global”). No qualifying bids were submitted by any other parties as to the Property. Hearing no objections, and having considered the pleadings, arguments of counsel, relevant law, and, for the reasons stated on the record, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion to Sell is GRANTED;
2. The Trustee is authorized to sell the Property to Global free and clear of all liens, interests, and encumbrances pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 363(b) and (f).

<sup>1</sup> This Court has jurisdiction to hear and finally decide the Motion to Sell pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1334, 157, and the Order of Reference of the District Court.

3. The Trustee is authorized to execute any instruments necessary to effectuate the transfer of the Property described in the Motion to Sell;

4. The sale proceeds [REDACTED] shall be paid to the Trustee to be held pending further order of this Court;

5. Global is purchasing the Property in good faith and is a good faith buyer within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. 363(m); therefore, Global is entitled to the full protection of that provision.

6. The provisions of Rule 6004(h) shall not apply and the Trustee is authorized to proceed with the sale of the Property upon the entry of this Order.
