## ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

This Assignment is entered into effective this 28th day of October 2022 by and between Timothy H. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the Assignor's employment terms and agreement, in addition to the representations, warranties, covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows

1. In view of the good and valuable consideration recited herein and consistent with Assignor's employment terms and agreement, Assignor hereby assigns, transfers, and sets over unto the Assignee, its lawful successors and assigns, effective as of the date hereof, all right, title, and interest in and to the Intellectual Property and all divisions and continuations thereof, and all Letters Patent of the United States which may be granted thereon, and all reissues and reexaminations thereof and all rights to claim priority on the basis of such applications ( except as to foreign applications pending and patents issued prior to the Effective Date hereof and all renewals and reexaminations thereof) and hereby authorizes Assignee to request on its behalf to the Patent and Trademark Office of the United States to issue all Letters Patent of such inventions(s) to Assignee, its successors and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this Assignment, including the right to seek and obtain for Assignee's own benefit injunctive relief and recovery of damages for any past and/or future infringements, including enhanced damages and/or attorney's fees for willful infringement.

2. Assignor covenants with Assignee, its successors and assigns that no assignment, sale, or agreement has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this Assignment.
