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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Frank Rimpl, residing at Saint-Gingolph, Switzerland (individual hereinafter "INVENTOR"), invented certain new and useful improvements, technology, inventions, developments, ideas, ornamental design or discoveries related to **BATTERY MODULE FOR ELECTRICALLY-DRIVEN AIRCRAFT** (collectively hereinafter referred to as the "Work") for which an application for Letters Patent in the United States has been filed or prepared for filing (identified above) with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (hereinafter the "Application"). The Application issued October 19, 2021 as U.S. Patent No. 11,148,819.

WHEREAS, INVENTOR invented such Work in the ordinary course of his or her employment with INGENIEURBÜRO.

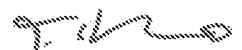
WHEREAS, INVENTOR may have previously assigned rights, title, or interest in and to the Work and the Application to INGENIEURBÜRO.

WHEREAS, H55 SA, a Swiss Corporation, with its principal place of business at Route de Chandoline 25E, 1950 Sion, Switzerland (hereinafter the "ASSIGNEE"), entered into an agreement with INGENIEURBÜRO whereby INGENIEURBÜRO agreed that ASSIGNEE would own the entire right, title, and interest in and to the Application and the Work.

AND WHEREAS, INVENTOR and INGENIEURBÜRO (collectively hereinafter "ASSIGNOR") desire to confirm that ASSIGNEE has acquired the entire right, title, and interest of INVENTOR and INGENIEURBÜRO in and to the Application and the Work.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration of which receipt is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR hereby acknowledges that ASSIGNOR has sold, assigned, transferred, and set over, and by these presents does hereby sell, assign, transfer, and set over, unto said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, the entire right, title, and interest throughout the world in and to the Application and the Work, including: all provisional and nonprovisional applications relating to the Work and the Application (including but not limited to U.S. Patent Application No. 17/064012, filed October 6, 2020); all nonprovisional applications claiming priority to aforementioned provisional(s), nonprovisional(s), and/or the Application, including, all divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, and reissues, and all Letters Patent of the United States which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof; and all rights of priority under International Conventions and any related Letters Patent which may hereafter be granted or filed in any country or countries foreign to the United States, all extensions, renewals, and reissues thereof. ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner for Patents of the United States, and any Official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all related Letters Patent to the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns.

AND ASSIGNOR DOES HEREBY acknowledge and agree that the assigned scope of the Application and the Work includes any currently recited claims, all embodiments, and all claims supported by the Application; Assignor agrees not to contest or disparage claim scope thus supported (including in any later-filed continuing patent applications) for any claims deemed patentable by any government patent office. Assignor also agrees not to challenge the validity, including as a defense to patent



infringement, of any issued patent claims resulting from or based on the Work, regardless of the scope of any such claims.

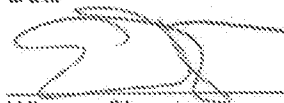
AND ASSIGNOR DOES HEREBY sell, assign, transfer, and convey to ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns all claims for damages and all remedies arising out of any violation of the rights assigned hereby that may have accrued prior to the date of assignment to ASSIGNEE, or may accrue hereafter, including, but not limited to, the right to sue for, collect, and retain damages for past infringements of said Letters Patent before or after issuance.

AND ASSIGNOR DOES HEREBY covenant and agree that ASSIGNOR will: communicate to said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns any facts known to ASSIGNOR respecting the Work; testify in any legal proceeding; assist in the preparation of any other provisional or non-provisional applications relating to the Application and the Work or any improvements made thereto; sign/execute all lawful papers; authorize the filing of, execute, and make all rightful oaths and/or declarations in connection with the Application and the Work including any improvements made thereto, any patent applications filed therefrom, and any continuing application filed from any of the aforementioned applications; and generally do everything possible to aid the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for the Work in all countries.

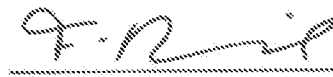
AND ASSIGNOR DOES HEREBY agree that if any term or provision of this agreement becomes invalid or unenforceable, the remainder shall survive unaffected.
