# Patent Assignment Deed

## Parties:

1. **PLAYGROUND XYZ IP PTY LTD (ACN 607 532 025)**  
of 13/50 Carrington Street, NSW 2000, Australia (“Assignor”)
2. **PLAYGROUND (XYZ) HOLDINGS PTY LTD (ACN 607 526 027)**  
of 13/50 Carrington Street, NSW 2000, Australia (“Assignee”)

## Background:

- A. Assignor is the registered owner or applicant of the Patent Rights.
- B. Assignor now wishes to assign certain patent rights to Assignee on the terms and conditions of this deed.

## Terms and Conditions:

### 1. Definitions

1.1 In this deed **Patent Rights** mean:

- (a) the patent applications and granted patents listed in the Schedule;
- (b) all patent applications and patents that are based on, or claim priority from, or are divided from, or are continuations of, or are patents of addition of, any patent application or patent described in paragraph (a); and
- (c) all patents which may be granted pursuant to any of the patent applications referred to in paragraphs (a) or (b).

### 2. Assignment

2.1 In consideration of the sum of A\$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Assignor, the Assignor hereby assigns to the Assignee:

- (a) the Assignor's entire legal and beneficial right, title and interest in the Patent Rights, including the right to make other applications for patent based on the Patent Rights;
- (b) the Assignor's copyright to the specifications and any drawings relating to the Patent Rights; and
- (c) the right to sue for any infringement relating to the Patent Rights occurring prior to the date of this Agreement and the right to recover damages for that infringement.

2.2 Assignor agrees at the request of Assignee to execute any document necessary to notify relevant authorities of the assignment of the Patent Rights and otherwise to give effect to this deed.

2.3 Assignor agrees to do all acts, including executing all documents, necessary or desirable to give full effect to this Deed, including documents relating to further applications, in Australia or elsewhere, for patent, registered design and/or other intellectual property rights in relation to the Patent Rights.

**3. General**

- 3.1 Each party is to bear its own costs arising out of the negotiation, preparation, execution and (subject to other provisions of this deed) performance of this deed, however Assignee must pay any applicable stamp duty and fees in connection with the assignment of the Patent Rights and notification of the relevant authorities.
- 3.2 No amendment or variation of this Deed is valid or binding on a party unless made in writing and executed by all parties.
- 3.3 This deed may be executed in any number of counterparts. All counterparts taken together will be taken to constitute one document. An executed counterpart may be delivered by facsimile or other electronic means.
- 3.4 If any provision of this Deed is held by a court to be unlawful, invalid, unenforceable or in conflict with any rule of law, statute, ordinance or regulation, it is to be severed so that the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions are not affected.
- 3.5 The following rules of interpretation apply unless the context requires otherwise.
  - (a) Headings are for convenience only and do not affect interpretation.
  - (b) The singular includes the plural and conversely.
  - (c) A reference to any party to this deed or any other deed or document includes the party's successors and permitted assigns.
- 3.6 This deed is governed by and construed in accordance with the law from time to time in the State of New South Wales and the parties agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of New South Wales.
