INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION AGREEMENT

THIS INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION AGREEMENT (this "IP Assignment") is made and entered into as of June 24, 2022, by and between and Glass Investments Projects, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Seller"), and Houweling Intellectual Properties, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Buyer").

WHEREAS, Seller and Buyer have entered into that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of the date hereof (the "Purchase Agreement"), pursuant to which Seller has agreed to sell, assign, transfer, convey and deliver to Buyer, and Buyer has agreed to purchase, acquire and accept from Seller, the entire right, title and interest of Seller (both present and future) in, to and under the Transferred Assets; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Purchase Agreement, Seller has conveyed, transferred and assigned to Buyer, certain Intellectual Property of Seller, and has agreed to execute and deliver this IP Assignment, for recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office, and corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, Seller and Buyer, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignment. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Seller hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers and assigns to Buyer, and Buyer hereby accepts, all of Seller's right, title and interest in and to the following (the "Transferred Intellectual Property"):
 - (a) the patents and patent applications set forth on Schedule 1 hereto and all issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations and renewals thereof (the "Patents");
 - (b) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Seller accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions and otherwise throughout the world;
 - (c) any and all royalties, fees, income, payments and other proceeds relating to the period following closing or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and
 - (d) any and all claims and causes of action, with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on and/or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present and future infringement, dilution, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.
2. Recordation and Further Actions. Seller hereby authorizes the Commissioner for Patents in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the officials of corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions to record and register this IP Assignment upon request by Buyer. In respect of any affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney, or other documents, that may

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be reasonably necessary to effect, evidence or perfect the assignment of the Transferred Intellectual Property to Buyer or any assignee or successor thereto, Seller shall comply with its obligations under the Purchase Agreement.

3. Successors and Assigns. This IP Assignment shall bind and inure to the benefit of Buyer and Seller and their respective successors and permitted assigns.
4. Governing Law. All matters relating to or arising out of this IP Assignment and the transactions contemplated hereby (whether sounding on contract, tort or otherwise) will be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Delaware without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law provision or rule that would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Delaware.
5. No Third-Party Beneficiaries. The terms and provisions of this IP Assignment are intended solely for the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and permitted assigns, and it is not the intention of the parties to confer third-party beneficiary rights, and this IP Assignment does not confer any such rights, upon any other Person.
6. Counterparts and Electronic Signature. This IP Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, and by the different parties hereto in separate counterparts, each of which when executed shall be deemed to be an original but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this IP Assignment by facsimile or other electronic transmission shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart to this IP Assignment.
