
ORDER ADMITTING WILL TO PROBATE

I, **Albert David Audette, Jr.**, of Collier County, Florida, being of sound mind and under no restraint, hereby publish and declare this instrument to be my Last Will and Testament, revoking all previous Wills and Codicils I have made.

ARTICLE I

I am single. I have 4 children; namely, Stephen Thomas Audette, Jeffrey Brian Audette, Michelle Mary Ridge, and Teresa Ann Robinson.

ARTICLE II

I contemplate making a separate writing in which I devise certain items of my tangible personal property, to those persons designated in the separate writing. This writing will be in existence at the time of my death, signed by me, and will describe the items devised with reasonable certainty, directing my Personal Representative to distribute such items. If no such list is found within thirty (30) days following my death, it may be assumed that no such list exists.

ARTICLE III

I hereby give all of the remainder of my personal property to my children, Stephen Thomas Audette, Jeffrey Brian Audette, Michelle Mary Ridge, and Teresa Ann Robinson, equally, per stirpes. The costs of packing, shipping and insuring the remainder of my personal property shall be paid as a cost of administration of my estate.

ARTICLE IV

I hereby give the entire rest and residue of my estate to my children, Stephen Thomas Audette, Jeffrey Brian Audette, Michelle Mary Ridge, and Teresa Ann Robinson, equally, per stirpes. The cost of packing, shipping and insuring the remainder of my property shall be paid as a cost of administration of my estate.



ARTICLE V

I hereby give in fee simple to my children, Stephen Thomas Audette, Jeffrey Brian Audette, Michelle Mary Ridge, and Teresa Ann Robinson, equally, per stirpes, all of the right, title, and interest which I own at the time of my death in and to my homestead property, and all adjoining same, wherever situated, together with all improvements thereon and used in connection therewith, and all insurance related thereto.

ARTICLE VI

I nominate and appoint my son, Jeffrey Brian Audette, as my Personal Representative of this my Last Will and Testament. If my son, Jeffrey Brian Audette, is unwilling or unable to serve, I appoint my daughter, Teresa Ann Robinson, as Personal Representative of this my Last Will and Testament.

ARTICLE VII

I direct my Personal Representative to do all acts which my Personal Representative deems necessary or appropriate in order to carry out the provisions and achieve the purposes of this, my Last Will and Testament, including the power to sell property (real, personal and mixed) and distribute the proceeds of such sale as part of my estate. The decisions of my Personal Representative relative thereto shall be final and binding on all concerned.

ARTICLE VIII

I direct my Personal Representative to pay all of my legally enforceable debts, the expenses of my funeral and burial or cremation, and of the administration of my estate.

ARTICLE IX

I authorize my Personal Representative to utilize the services of an attorney, accountant and any other professional as may be necessary or desirable in the administration of this, my Last Will and Testament. The expenses incurred by the Personal Representative using such professional services shall be an expense to my estate and shall be paid by my estate.

ARTICLE X

I direct my Personal Representative to pay all inheritance, transfer, estate and similar taxes on any property or interest in property included in my estate for the purpose of computing taxes. My Personal Representative shall not require any beneficiary under this will to reimburse my estate for taxes paid on property passing under the terms of this will.

ARTICLE XI

My Personal Representative shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for services actually performed and to reimbursement for expenses properly incurred.

ARTICLE XII

It is not my intention to make provisions in this my Last Will and Testament for any person not expressly provided for herein, except for children born to or legally adopted by me after the date of this instrument, and if any such person has not been expressly mentioned herein and expressly provided for herein, he or she has been omitted by me intentionally and with full knowledge of his or her relationship and existence.

ARTICLE XIII

Where appropriate to the context, pronouns or other terms expressed in one number or gender shall be deemed to include the other number or gender, as the case may be.

ARTICLE XIV

Any person named or referred to herein shall be deemed to have survived me only if such person shall, in fact, survive me for a period of at least thirty (30) days. Any person named or referred to herein who shall not survive me for a period of at least thirty (30) days shall be deemed to have died before I do.


