2. Assignment of Patents. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, Assignor hereby unconditionally and irrevocably assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee, its successors and assigns, all of its world-wide right, title, and interest, in, to, and under the following (collectively, "Acquired Rights"):

(a) the patents and patent applications listed in Schedule 1, and all substitutions, reissues, re-examinations, and renewals, of any of the foregoing (collectively "Acquired Patents");

(b) all licenses and similar contractual rights or permissions, whether exclusive or nonexclusive, related to any of the Acquired Patents ("Licenses");

(c) the right to claim for any applications the full benefits and priority rights of any international agreement between the United States and any foreign country or countries,

(d) all royalties, fees, income, payments, and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable to Seller with respect to any of the foregoing;

(e) all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on, or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present, and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, breach, or default; and

(f) all other rights, privileges, and protections of any kind whatsoever of Assignor accruing under any of the foregoing provided by any applicable law, treaty, or other international convention throughout the world.

3. Further Assurances. Assignor shall execute any instruments or documents and perform all other acts reasonably necessary or appropriate, in the reasonable discretion of the Assignee, its successors and assigns, to further evidence the intent and purpose of this Assignment.

4. Entire Agreement. This Assignment, together with Schedule 1, constitutes the sole and entire agreement of the parties to this Assignment with respect to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous understandings, agreements, representations and warranties, both written and oral, with respect to such subject matter.

5. Successors and Assigns. This Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

6. Governing Law. The laws of the State of Delaware, without giving effect to its conflicts of laws principles, shall govern all matters arising out of, in connection with, or relating to this Assignment including, without limitation, the validity, interpretation, construction, performance, and enforcement thereof.

7. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Assignment by facsimile, portable document format or other electronic means shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart to this Assignment.
