PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT (this "**Patent Assignment**"), dated as of November 30, 2023 is made by Malcolm Fontier, Gareth Brown, Stephen Kaes, and Matthew Chin (collectively, the "**Inventors**"), in favor of Pakt, Inc. ("**Assignee**"), a Delaware corporation, located at 424 E, Main Street Suite 203A Bozeman, Montana 59715. Inventors and Assignee enter into this Patent Assignment in connection with that certain Design Proposal Agreement executed on or about February 8, 2018 (the "**Design Agreement**").

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Design Agreement, Inventors has conveyed, transferred, and assigned to Assignee, among other assets, certain intellectual property of Inventors; and

(a) the invention(s) described in the patent application entitled "Coffee-making kit" (Design Patent Application number: 29/696,665. Design Patent Number: D945810) attached hereto, all patents and patent applications in connection therewith, issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations, and renewals in connection therewith (the "**Patents**");

(b) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Inventors accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions, and otherwise throughout the world;

(c) any and all royalties, fees, income, payments, and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and

(d) any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on, or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present, and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach, or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.

2. Recordation and Further Actions. Inventors hereby authorize the Commissioner for Patents in the United States Patent and Trademark Office to record and register this Patent Assignment upon request by Assignee. Following the date hereof, Inventors shall take such steps and actions, and provide such cooperation and assistance to Assignee and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, including the execution and delivery of any affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments, powers of attorney, or other documents, as may be necessary to effect, evidence, or perfect the assignment of the Assigned Patents to Assignee, or any assignee or successor thereto.

3. Counterparts. This Patent Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this Patent Assignment delivered by facsimile, e-mail, or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Patent Assignment.

4. Successors and Assigns. This Patent Assignment shall be binding upon and shall insure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

5. Governing Law. This Patent Assignment and any claim, controversy, dispute, or cause of action (whether in contract, tort, or otherwise) based upon, arising out of, or relating to this Patent Assignment and the transactions contemplated hereby shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the State of New York, without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of New York or any other jurisdiction).
