



ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, 知的財産本部 (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Getting paper copies

If you do not agree with this process, please let us know as described below.
