U.S. Application Serial Number 16/532,145 filed on August 5, 2019, which claimed priority to U.S. Application Serial Number 15/463,937 and U.S. Provisional Application No. 62/311,257, and which issued into U.S. Patent No. 10,808,403 on October 20, 2020.

WHEREAS, I am an owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents, and in and to any foreign patents and applications, and all continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, reexaminations, and extensions thereof (collectively the “Patents”).

WHEREAS, at the time conceiving of the invention I was under an obligation to assign my entire right, title and interest in and to my invention and the Patents to **Nucor Corporation** (hereinafter the “Assignee”), having a place of business at 1915 Rexford Road Charlotte, NC 28211;

WHEREAS, I signed an assignment of the invention and the Patents to Verco Decking, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Nucor Corporation on September 12th, 2018, which was not recorded (hereinafter the “Previous Assignment”);

AND WHEREAS, I wish to confirm that, at the time of execution of the Previous Assignment, I was under an obligation to assign and intend to assign my entire right, title and interest in and to my invention and the Patents to the Assignee and by this Assignment, I am correcting the mistake made in the Previous Assignment that listed Verco Decking, Inc., as opposed to the Assignee;



with full benefit of such priorities as may now or hereafter be granted to me by local laws or by treaty, including any international convention for the protection of industrial property, together with the right to extend the protection of said United States Letters Patent to the various territorial possessions now owned or which may be hereafter acquired by the United States of America, all said rights to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee for its use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors or assigns, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me if this assignment and sale had not been made. And I do hereby request and authorize the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and any officials of foreign countries whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all said Letters Patent, when granted, in accordance with the terms of this assignment.

I further covenant and agree with the Assignee that I have full and unencumbered title to the invention and Patents herein assigned, which title I warrant unto the Assignee, and I further agree that, when requested, I will, without demanding any further consideration therefor but at the expense of Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgement of instruments, that may be or become necessary for obtaining, sustaining or reissuing United States or foreign Letters Patent for the said invention and Patents, and for maintaining and perfecting the Assignee's right to said invention, Patents and Letters Patent particularly in cases of interference and litigation.
