AFFIDAVIT OF ANDREW MARKESE

COMES NOW, the affiant, Andrew Markese, who states as follows:


1. I am the President and Chief Executive Officer of Image Sensing Systems, Inc., a Minnesota corporation ("ISS"). I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and am authorized to make this affidavit on behalf of ISS.
2. ISS and EIS Electronic Integrated Systems, Inc., a corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario ("EIS"), are parties to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated December 6, 2007, pursuant to which EIS sold ISS certain assets (the "Assets").
3. As part of the purchase price for such Assets, ISS agreed to pay EIS certain earnout payments (the "Earn-Out Consideration"), and ISS granted EIS a security interest in the Assets, including without limitation, the patent applications listed on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein (collectively, the "Patent Applications"), as security for the satisfaction of the payment of the Earn-Out Consideration, as further described in that certain Intellectual Property Security and Pledge Agreement (the "Security Agreement"), dated December 6, 2007.
4. EIS filed the Security Agreement with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (the "USPTO") against the Patent Applications on or about December 6, 2007.
5. Pursuant to the Security Agreement, upon payment in full of the Earn-Out Consideration,
 - (i) the security interests and liens granted under the Security Agreement shall terminate;
 - (ii) EIS shall promptly file all appropriate UCC-3 termination statements and other terminations and/or releases to evidence such termination; and
 - (iii) EIS shall execute and deliver to ISS an instrument or instruments in the form and substance satisfactory to ISS in

order to release its security interest in the Patent Applications and other collateral (collectively, the "Releases").

6. All financial obligations of ISS related to the Earn-Out Consideration, as secured by the Security Agreement, have been fully satisfied and discharged as of February 3, 2012. Consequently, the lien interests created under the Security Agreement in respect of the Patent Applications and all other collateral has been extinguished.
7. Despite ISS's satisfaction of its obligations under the Security Agreement, EIS failed to provide the Releases to ISS. To the best of affiant's knowledge, EIS is no longer an operating entity and as such, it is unable to provide the required Releases at this time.
8. As a result of EIS's failure to adhere to its release requirements under the Security Agreement, such agreement continues to be listed as an encumbrance against the Patent Applications in the USPTO records, an anomaly that does not reflect the current, unencumbered status of the Patent Applications and should be disregarded.


