**STATEMENT PURSUANT TO U.S. TITLE 37 C.F.R. 1.64
REGARDING OWNERSHIP AND EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT OF
LUDOVIC NEVEU GOVERNED BY THE LAWS OF FRANCE**

I, Gaetan Mabilite, hereby state as follows:

1. I am a co-inventor of the application identified above, and am also an employee of Ingenico Terminals, the beneficiary of the Applicant, Banks and Acquirers International Holding;
2. Each of myself, Didier Coquelet, Ludovic Neveu, Johann Balasse and the Applicant are identified properly in the Application Data Sheet filed with the above-identified application on September 27, 2019;
3. As a named co-inventor, and employee of Ingenico Terminals, I am familiar with the facts surrounding the conception of the invention disclosed and claimed in the above-identified patent application and with the filing of a patent application in French Patent Application Number 1752771, filed on March 31, 2017, from which the above U.S. patent application claims priority;
4. My co-inventor Ludovic Neveu was an employee of Ingenico Terminals at the time the invention(s) disclosed in the above-patent application was conceived in France;
5. My co-inventor Ludovic Neveu contribution to the conception was performed within the scope of Ludovic Neveu employment and inventive mission at Ingenico Terminals;
6. It is my understanding that Ludovic Neveu is no longer an employee of Ingenico Terminals and is unreachable to execute the U.S. Declaration and a written assignment of his contribution to Ingenico Terminals. Mr. Ludovic Neveu's employment terminated after contribution to conception of the subject matter of the above-identified application;
7. Under the Patent Law of France, in particular under Article L611-7 of the French


Intellectual Property Code (IPC), Ingenico Terminals was the owner by operation of French law of the invention disclosed and claimed in the patent application in France having Application Number 1752771 at the time the application was filed on March 31, 2017, and all priority rights contained therein, and thus to the above-identified U.S. patent application;

8. Attached to this statement is a Memorandum corresponding to the above-mentioned Article L611-7 of the French IPC (Exhibit A);

9. I further declare that all statements made herein of my own knowledge are true and that all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true; and further that these statements were made with the knowledge that willful false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under Section 1001 of Title 18 of the United States Code, and that such willful false statements may jeopardize the validity of the above-referenced application or any patent issuing thereon.

MEMORANDUM ON PATENT LAW OF FRANCE

In pertinent part, Article L611-7 of the Intellectual Property Code of the current French patent law defines "invention made with an inventive mission" and the ownership thereof. Specifically, it provides that:


If the inventor is an employee, the right to the industrial property title in the absence of a contractual stipulation more favorable to the employee, is defined in accordance with the following provisions:

1. Invention made by an employee in the course of either a contract of employment which includes an inventive mission corresponding to his actual duties, or of studies and researches which have been explicitly entrusted to him, belong to the employer.

Referring to the Statement of Gaetan Mabilie, a co-inventor with Ludovic Neveu, co-inventor Ludovic Neveu's contribution to conception of the invention described in French Patent Application Number 1752771, filed on March 31, 2017, and thus any and all corresponding U.S. patent applications claiming priority therefrom, was derived from Ludovic Neveu's ordinary duties and inventive mission of the entity INGENICO TERMINALS pursuant to co-inventor Ludovic Neveu's employment with INGENICO TERMINALS. Thus, INGENICO TERMINALS has the right to patent the invention made with an inventive mission and is the owner of such invention with an inventive mission and of patents issuing therefrom.


