of invention, and the like that derive priority from, or claim the benefit of the filing date of, the Assigned Patents (the "Patents and Patent Applications") and of all new and useful inventions and improvements that are disclosed in the Patents and Patent Applications (the "Inventions" and together with the Patents and Patent Applications, the "Patent Assets"), including the right to file and prosecute, in Assignee's name wherever so permitted by law or in the name of Assignor wherever necessary, patent applications, including corresponding and continuing applications, reissues, re-examinations, certificates of invention, and the like based on any of the Patent Assets, and to claim priority to any of the Patents and Patent Applications pursuant to the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the Patent Cooperation Treaty, the European Patent Convention, and all other treaties of like purposes. Assignor hereby authorizes the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any officials of any countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to record patents, applications and title thereto, to record the Patents and Patent Applications and title thereto as the property of Assignee in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.


