PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT ("**Patent Assignment**"), dated as of January 16, 2024, *nunc pro tunc* effective as of April 20, 2023, is made by Veracity Limited, of PO Box 4501, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands ("**Assignor**"), in favor of Veracity Limited S.R.L, of Office 214, Escazú Avenue, Lexus Tower, 3rd Floor, Escazú, San José, Costa Rica ("**Assignee**"), the purchaser of all assets of Assignor pursuant to an ASSIGNMENT OF ASSETS between Assignee and Assignor dated as of April 20, 2023 (the "**Asset Assignment**").

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Asset Assignment, Assignor has conveyed, transferred, and assigned to Assignee, among other assets, certain intellectual property of Assignor, and has agreed to execute and deliver this Patent Assignment, for recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment. In consideration of the sum of One-hundred Dollars (\$100.00 USD), and for other good and valuable consideration described in the Asset Assignment, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers, and assigns to Assignee, and Assignee hereby accepts, all of Assignor's right, title, and interest in and to the following (the "**Assigned Patents**"):

i. the patents and patent applications set forth in Schedule 1 hereto and all issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations, and renewals thereof (the "**Patents**");

ii. all rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignor accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions, and otherwise throughout the world;

iii. any and all royalties, fees, income, payments, and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and

iv. any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on, or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present, and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach, or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.

2. Recordation and Further Actions. Assignor hereby authorizes the Commissioner for Patents in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the officials of corresponding entities or agencies in any applicable jurisdictions to record and register this Patent Assignment upon request by Assignee. Following the date hereof, upon Assignee's reasonable request, and at Assignee's sole cost and expense, Assignor shall take such steps and actions, and provide such cooperation and assistance to Assignee and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, including the execution and delivery of any affidavits, declarations, oaths, exhibits, assignments,

powers of attorney, or other documents, as may be reasonably necessary to effect, evidence, or perfect the assignment of the Assigned Patents to Assignee, or any assignee or successor thereto.

3. Terms of the Asset Assignment. The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that this Patent Assignment is entered into pursuant to the Asset Assignment, to which reference is made for a further statement of the rights and obligations of Assignor and Assignee with respect to the Assigned Patents. The representations, warranties, covenants, agreements, and indemnities contained in the Asset Assignment shall not be superseded hereby but shall remain in full force and effect to the full extent provided therein. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the terms of the Asset Assignment and the terms hereof, the terms of the Asset Assignment shall govern.

4. Counterparts. This Patent Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this Patent Assignment delivered by facsimile, e-mail, or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Patent Assignment.

5. Successors and Assigns. This Patent Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

6. Arbitration.

i. Subject to Section 6.vi, any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Patent Assignment, including any question regarding its existence, validity or termination, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration under the LCIA Rules, which Rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference into this Section 6.

ii. The number of arbitrators shall be one.

iii. The seat, or legal place, of arbitration shall be London, England.

iv. The language to be used in the arbitral proceedings shall be English.

v. Arbitration pursuant to this Section 6 shall be the sole and exclusive forum for resolution of any dispute relating to this Patent Assignment, and the award shall be in writing, state the reasons for the award and be final and binding. Judgment thereon may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

vi. Without prejudice to any other rights or remedies that the parties may have, the parties hereby acknowledge and agree that damages alone may not be an adequate remedy for any breach of the terms of this Patent Assignment. Accordingly, the parties shall be entitled to seek the remedies of injunction, specific performance or other equitable relief for any threatened or actual breach of the terms of this Patent Assignment.

7. Governing Law. This Patent Assignment and any claim, controversy, dispute, or cause of action (whether in contract, tort, or otherwise) based upon, arising out of, or relating to this

Patent Assignment and the transactions contemplated hereby shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the England and Wales.
