THIS DEED OF ASSIGNMENT is made the 1st day of November 2021

BETWEEN: Professor Kingston Mills of the School of Biochemistry & Immunology, Trinity College Dublin, Dublin 2 (hereinafter ‘the Inventor’)

AND: The Provost, Fellows, Foundation Scholars and the other members of Board of the College of the Holy and Undivided Trinity of Queen Elizabeth, near Dublin (hereinafter ‘the University’)

WHEREAS the Inventor claims to be a first and true inventor of an invention relating to **“Treatment and Prevention of Neuropathology Associated with Neurodegenerative Diseases”** TCD ref: ML01-1111-01 (hereinafter ‘the Invention’); and

WHEREAS (a) the Inventor is an employee of the University and (b) the Invention was made by the Inventor in the course of their employment by the University; and

WHEREAS the Inventor has agreed that the Invention and all intellectual property rights therein shall be held by the University in accordance with its Policy, Practice and Regulations on Intellectual Property, 2022 (hereinafter “University IP policy”); and

WHEREAS the University wishes to obtain protection for the Invention by applying for patents in relation to the Invention

THIS DEED OF ASSIGNMENT PROVIDES:

1. The Inventor hereby assigns to the University absolutely their entire right, title and interest in and to:
 - a. the Invention, any improvements or modification to the Invention, design rights in the Invention, copyright in the Invention and all know-how relating to the Invention;
 - b. all rights and powers to make application for patents, supplementary protection certificates and divisions, reissues and extensions of patents, continuations, continuations in part and design rights in the name of the University or jointly with others or in the name of its nominee, in relation to the Invention or any improvements or modifications to the Invention;
 - c. all rights and benefits arising from such application under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property.
2. The Inventor agrees that the University may assign or licence the rights to any third party of its choice for any purpose including the commercial exploitation of the Invention.
3. The Inventor will, at the expense of the University, do all acts and execute all documents necessary or desirable for further assuring the title of the University to the invention and for obtaining and securing patent and corresponding protection in any territory, as may be required by the University.
