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**INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY  
RELEASE AND REASSIGNMENT**

This **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RELEASE AND REASSIGNMENT** (the “**Release and Reassignment**”) is made effective as of August 1, 2024 by JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., a national banking association, Individually as a Bank and as Administrative Agent and Collateral Agent for the Banks (the “**Secured Party**”), in favor of Vac-Con, Inc., a Delaware corporation (the “**Grantor**”).

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, Grantor, together with its parent Holden Industries, Inc., a Delaware corporation (the “**Parent**”) and certain other subsidiaries of Parent, and the Secured Party entered into the Loan and Security Agreement, dated as of December 28, 2007 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the “**Loan Agreement**”) and Grantor and Secured Party entered the Security Interest Grant Intellectual Property dated as of December 28, 2007 and recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (the “**USPTO**”) on March 26, 2008 at Reel 020704 Frame 0110 and on March 26, 2008 at Reel 3746 Frame 0765 (the “**IP Security Agreement**”; capitalized terms used herein but not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in the Security Agreement or IP Security Agreement);

**WHEREAS**, as partial security for the Liabilities, pursuant to the Loan Agreement and IP Security Agreement, Grantor granted to Secured Party a continuing security interest in the IP Collateral; and

**WHEREAS**, the Liabilities have been fully satisfied and, therefore, the Grantor has requested that Secured Party release its security interest in the IP Collateral and reassign the IP Collateral to Grantor.


**NOW THEREFORE**, for good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged:

1. Secured Party hereby terminates the IP Security Agreement and releases its continuing security interest in the IP Collateral, including the foregoing on Schedule A and Schedule B attached hereto.
2. Secured Party hereby reassigns, grants and conveys to Grantor, without any representation, recourse or undertaking by Secured Party, all of Secured Party's right, title and interest, in and to the IP Collateral.
3. Secured Party authorizes the recordation of this Release and Reassignment with the USPTO at Grantor's expense.
