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RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS

This RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS (this “Release”), dated as of November 19, 2024 (the “Effective Date”), is made by BANK OF AMERICA, N.A., in its capacity as Agent (the “Agent”) for the Secured Parties, in favor of INTERMEDIX OFFICE BASED, LLC a Delaware limited liability company with an address at 401 N. Michigan Avenue, Suite 2700, Chicago, Illinois 60611, INTERMEDIX CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation with an address at 401 N. Michigan Avenue, Suite 2700, Chicago, Illinois 60611, R1 RCM INC., a Delaware corporation with an address at 401 N. Michigan Avenue, Suite 2700, Chicago, Illinois 60611, SCHEDULING.COM, INC., a Delaware corporation with an address at 720 3rd Avenue, Suite 1000, Seattle, Washington 98104, IVINCI PARTNERS, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company with an address at 1555 W. Shoreline Drive, Suite 150, Boise, Idaho 83702, PAR80, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company with an address at 170 Milk Street #2, Boston, Massachusetts 02109 and ADVATA INC., a Delaware corporation with an address at 205 108th Avenue NE, Suite 300, Bellevue, Washington 98004 (collectively, the “Grantors” and each a “Grantor”).

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Security Agreement, dated as of June 26, 2019, by and among the Agent, the Grantors and certain other parties thereto (as amended and restated as of June 21, 2022 and as further amended, amended and restated, or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Security Agreement”), the Grantors granted to the Agent, in its capacity as Agent, the Security Interest (as defined below) in and to certain collateral;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Security Agreement, the Grantors executed and delivered the following: Intellectual Property Security Agreements, dated as of June 26, 2019 (the “2019 Intellectual Property Security Agreements”), Security Agreement Supplement for Intellectual Property, dated as of June 8, 2020 (the “2020 Security Agreement Supplement”), that certain Security Agreement Supplement for Intellectual Property, dated as of July 1, 2021 (the “2021 Security Agreement Supplement”), that certain Security Agreement Supplement for Intellectual Property, dated as of June 21, 2022 (the “2022 Security Agreement Supplement”), and that certain Security Agreement Supplement for Intellectual Property, dated as of March 14, 2024 (the “2024 Security Agreement Supplement” and together with the 2020 Security Agreement Supplement, the 2021 Security Agreement Supplement and 2022 Security Agreement Supplement, the “Patent Security Agreements”), for recordal with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (“USPTO”);

WHEREAS, the Patent Security Agreements were recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on July 1, 2019, June 8, 2020, July 1, 2021, June 21, 2022 and March 15, 2024 at Reel/Frame 049636/0547, 049636/0677, 052875/0481, 056751/0452, 060390/0385 and 066944/0699, respectively;

WHEREAS, each Grantor granted the Agent, under the terms of the Patent Security Agreements and the Security Agreement, a security interest (the “Security Interest”) in favor of the Agent, in all of each such Grantor’s right, title or interest in or to the IP Collateral (as such term is used in the Patent Security Agreements), including without limitation the Patents (as such term is used in the Patent Security Agreements) and Patents for which applications are pending listed in **Schedule I**.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Agent hereby agrees as follows:

1. Defined Terms. All capitalized terms used, but not otherwise defined herein, shall have the respective meanings ascribed in or otherwise referenced in the Security Agreement or the Patent Security Agreements, as applicable.

2. Release. The Agent, without representation or warranty of any kind, hereby releases, discharges, terminates and cancels all of its Security Interest in and to the IP Collateral, including the Patents and Patent applications set forth in Schedule I attached hereto, arising under the Security Agreement and the Patent Security Agreements. If and to the extent that the Agent has acquired any right, title or interest in and to the IP Collateral, the Agent, without representation or warranty of any kind, hereby re-transfers, re-conveys and re-assigns such right, title or interest to the Grantors. Each Grantor (and any successor to such Grantor, including any person or entity hereafter holding any right, title or interest in and to the IP Collateral) is hereby authorized to record this Release with the USPTO.


3. Termination. The Agent, without representation or warranty of any kind, terminates and cancels the Patent Security Agreements.

4. Further Assurances. The Agent agrees to take all further actions, and provide to the Grantors and their respective successors, assigns or other legal representatives, all such cooperation and assistance (including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of any and all documents or other instruments), reasonably requested by the Grantors, at the Grantors' sole cost and expense, to more fully and effectively effectuate the purposes of this Release.

5. Governing Law. This Release shall be governed exclusively under the laws of New York, without regard to conflicts of law or choice of law principles.
