## ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Assignment Agreement (this “**Assignment**”) is made and entered into as of October 1, 2024 (the “**Execution Date**”), by ML Tech, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company having and address at 2515 McKinney Avenue, Suite 1000-A, Dallas, TX 75201 (“**Assignor**”) and Venturi IP LLC, a Delaware limited liability company having an address at 1345 Avenue of the Americas, 46th Floor, New York, NY 10105 (“**Assignee**”).

### RECITALS

A. Assignor is the owner of United States Patent listed in the table below (the “**Patent**”):

- B. Assignor and Assignee have agreed by way of a Patent Assignment Agreement dated October [31], 2016 (the “**Agreement**”), that Assignor shall sell, transfer, and assign and set over unto Assignee and Assignee shall accept, all rights, title and interest in and to certain patents as specified in an Assignment, effective as of October 17, 2016 (the “**Effective Date**”).
- C. The Patent was inadvertently excluded from the Agreement and Assignee and Assignor are entering into this Assignment to amend the Agreement to include the Patent *nunc pro tunc* as of the Effective Date.
- D. Assignee and Assignor are executing this Assignment to memorialize the assignment of the Patent from Assignee to Assignor *nunc pro tunc* as of the Effective Date.

### AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, and the covenants and agreements in this Assignment, Assignor and Assignee agree as follows:

1. *Nunc pro tunc* as of the Effective Date, the Agreement is hereby amended such that the “Effective Date” of the Agreement is corrected to October 17, 2016 and the Patent is included in the list of “Patents” listed on Exhibit A to the Agreement. The Agreement is hereby incorporated into this Agreement by reference. In the event of any conflict between the terms of this Assignment Agreement and the referenced Agreement, the terms of the Agreement shall prevail.
2. *Nunc pro tunc* as of the Effective Date, Assignor does hereby sell, transfer, convey, assign and deliver to Assignee all of Assignor’s right, privilege, title and interest in, to and under the Patent and in the case of patent applications in and to any Patent that may issue therefrom, including, in all instances, any counterparts of any of the foregoing in any jurisdiction throughout the world, and any and all divisions, continuations, reissues or reexaminations of any of the

foregoing, and, further, all applications for industrial property protection, including without limitation, all applications for Patent, utility models, copyright, and designs which may hereafter be filed for any inventions described in said Patent in any country or countries, together with the right to file such applications and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from the inventions and the Patent under the laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable, in each instance the same to be held by Assignee for Assignee's own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of Assignee's successors, assigns and other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this Assignment and sale had not been made; together with all claims for damages, royalties, income or other remuneration (hereinafter "**Damages**") by reason of past, present and future infringements of the Patent or other rights being assigned hereunder, along with the right to sue for and collect such Damages for the use and benefit of Assignee and its successors, assigns and other legal representatives.

3. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner for Patent of the United States, and any officer of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue Patent or other evidence or forms of intellectual property protection or applications as aforesaid, to issue the same to Assignee and its successors, assigns and other legal representatives in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

4. Assignor authorizes and empowers Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives or nominees, to invoke and claim for any application for patent or other form of protection for the inventions, the benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable, and to invoke and claim such right of priority without further written or oral authorization from Assignor.



Assignor hereby consents that a copy of this Agreement shall be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file or like document that may be required in any country for any purpose and more particularly in proof of the right of Assignee or nominee to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it.
