as Collateral Agent

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THIRD AMENDED AND RESTATED SECURITY AGREEMENT

This THIRD AMENDED AND RESTATED SECURITY AGREEMENT, dated as of April 18, 2008 (this "Agreement"), between each of the Grantors (as defined below) and JPMORGAN CHASE BANK, N.A. (together with its successors and assigns in such capacity the "Collateral Agent") acting in the capacity of collateral agent for the benefit of the Secured Parties (as defined below) from time to time in accordance with the terms of the Intercreditor Agreement (as defined below).

RECITALS

A. (i) Citizens Bank of Pennsylvania ("Citizens"), as Administrative Agent (in such capacity, the "2004 Administrative Agent") on behalf of the lenders from time to time party thereto, and certain of the Grantors entered into an Amended and Restated Loan Agreement dated as of June 29, 2004 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time immediately prior to the effectiveness hereof, the "2004 Credit Agreement"); (ii) Citizens as Collateral Agent (in such capacity, the "2004 Collateral Agent") and as the 2004 Administrative Agent, certain lenders and noteholders party thereto and certain of the Grantors entered into an Intercreditor and Collateral Agency Agreement dated as of June 29, 2004 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time immediately prior to the effectiveness hereof, the "2004 Intercreditor Agreement"); and (iii) the 2004 Collateral Agent and certain of the Grantors entered into a Security Agreement dated as of June 29, 2004 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time immediately prior to the effectiveness hereof, the "2004 Security Agreement"), pursuant to which the obligations of such Grantors (whether direct or guarantee obligations) in respect of (a) the 2004 Credit Agreement and certain related agreements and (b) the Senior Notes due 2014 (as amended, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "2004 Notes") issued and sold pursuant to the terms and conditions of a note purchase agreement dated as of June 29, 2004 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, including pursuant to the Fifth Amendment Agreement dated as of the date hereof, the "2004 Note Purchase Agreement") among the Grantors and the financial institutions identified as the purchasers of the 2004 Notes (together with the successors and transferees thereof, the "2004 Noteholders") are secured by the collateral on the terms set forth therein.

B. (i) Certain Grantors, the lenders party thereto from time to time (the "Revolver Lenders") and JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. ("JPMCB"), as Administrative Agent for such lenders (the "Revolver Administrative Agent"), entered into a Loan Agreement dated as of January 31, 2006 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "2006 Credit Agreement"), which refinanced and replaced the 2004 Credit Agreement, (ii) JPMCB replaced Citizens as the Collateral Agent under the 2004 Intercreditor Agreement and the 2004 Security Agreement and, to that end, (x) the Collateral Agent and such Grantors entered into an Amended and Restated Security Agreement dated as of January 31, 2006 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time prior to the date hereof, the "2006 Security Agreement"), which replaced the 2004 Security Agreement and (y) the Collateral Agent, the Revolver Administrative Agent, the 2004 Noteholders and such Grantors entered into an Amended and Restated Intercreditor and Collateral Agency Agreement dated as of January 31, 2006 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "2006 Intercreditor Agreement"), which replaced the 2004 Intercreditor Agreement

and governed the respective rights and remedies of the Revolver Lenders and the 2004 Noteholders with respect to the Collateral subject to the 2006 Security Agreement,

C. (i) Certain Grantors party thereto, the Revolver Lenders and the Revolver Administrative Agent entered into a First Amended and Restated Loan Agreement dated as of August 22, 2007 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Revolving Credit Agreement"), which amended and restated the 2006 Credit Agreement, (ii) the Collateral Agent and such Grantors entered into a Second Amended and Restated Security Agreement dated as of August 22, 2007 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time prior to the date hereof, the "2007 Security Agreement"), which amended and restated the 2006 Security Agreement and (iii) the Collateral Agent, the Revolver Administrative Agent, the 2004 Noteholders and such Grantors entered into a Second Amended and Restated Intercreditor and Collateral Agency Agreement, dated as of August 22, 2007 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "2007 Intercreditor Agreement"), which amended and restated the 2006 Intercreditor Agreement and governed the respective rights and remedies of the Revolver Lenders and the 2004 Noteholders with respect to the Collateral subject to the 2007 Security Agreement.

D. Contemporaneously herewith, (i) the Grantors, the lenders party thereto (the "Term Loan Lenders") and JPMCB, as Administrative Agent for such lenders (the "Term Loan Administrative Agent") are entering into a Term Loan Agreement dated as of April 18, 2008 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Term Loan Agreement"); (ii) the Grantors and the financial institutions identified as the purchasers thereof (together with the successors and transferees thereof, the "2008 Noteholders") are entering into a note purchase agreement dated as of April 18, 2008 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "2008 Note Purchase Agreement"), pursuant to which the Senior Notes due 2018 (as amended, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "2008 Notes") are being issued and sold; and (iii) the Collateral Agent, the Revolver Administrative Agent, the Term Loan Administrative Agent, the 2004 Noteholders, the 2008 Noteholders and the Grantors are entering into a Third Amended and Restated Intercreditor and Collateral Agency Agreement dated as of April 18, 2008 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Intercreditor Agreement"), which shall amend and restate the 2007 Intercreditor Agreement and govern the respective rights and remedies of the Secured Parties with respect to the Collateral subject to this Agreement.

E. The obligations of the Grantors pursuant to the Senior Secured Debt Documents and certain other agreements to certain of the Secured Parties are (or, with respect to any such obligations existing immediately prior to the occurrence of the Restatement Effective Date (as defined below) will continue) to be secured by the Collateral (as defined below), and each Grantor not party to the 2007 Security Agreement, by its execution and delivery of this Agreement, hereby assumes and agrees to all of the obligations of a Grantor hereunder and grants the security interests as provided herein.

F. The Collateral shall be shared on a ratable basis among the Secured Parties in accordance with the terms of the Intercreditor Agreement.

G. It is a condition precedent to the effectiveness of the Term Loan Agreement and the 2008 Note Purchase Agreement that the parties hereto shall have executed this Agreement, amending and restating the 2007 Security Agreement in its entirety as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the agreements, provisions and covenants herein contained, each Grantor and the Collateral Agent agree as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS.

(a) General Definitions. All capitalized terms used herein (including the preamble and recitals hereto) and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed thereto in the Intercreditor Agreement or, if not defined therein, in the UCC. In addition, in this Agreement, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

“Accounts” shall mean all “accounts” as defined in the UCC.

“Agreement” shall have the meaning set forth in the preamble.

“Authenticate” shall mean “authenticate” as defined in the UCC.

“Chattel Paper” shall mean all “chattel paper” as defined in the UCC, including, without limitation, “electronic chattel paper” or “tangible chattel paper”, as each term is defined in the UCC.

“Citizens” is defined in the Recitals.

“Collateral” shall mean any and all assets and rights and interests in or to property of the Grantors pledged from time to time as security for the Secured Obligations, or any of it, pursuant to this Agreement or any of the Senior Secured Debt Documents, whether now owned or hereafter acquired, including, without limitation, all of the property described in Section 2(a) below and all of the Accounts, Chattel Paper, Deposit Accounts, Documents, Equipment, Fixtures, General Intangibles (including, without limitation, all Intellectual Property), Inventory, Instruments, Investment Related Property and Proceeds of each Grantor.

“Collateral Agent” shall have the meaning set forth in the preamble.

“Collateral Records” shall mean books, records, ledger cards, files, correspondence, customer lists, blueprints, technical specifications, manuals, computer software, computer printouts, tapes, disks and other electronic storage media and related data processing software and similar items that at any time evidence or contain information relating to any of the Collateral or are otherwise necessary or helpful in the collection thereof or realization thereupon.

“Collateral Support” shall mean all property (real or personal) assigned, hypothecated or otherwise securing any Collateral and shall include any security agreement or other agreement granting a lien or security interest in such real or personal property.

“Commercial Tort Claims” shall mean all “commercial tort claims” as defined in the UCC, including, without limitation, all commercial tort claims listed on Schedule V hereto (as that schedule may be amended from time to time in accordance with Section 4(d) below).

“Commodities Accounts” shall mean all “commodity accounts” as defined in the UCC.

“Controlled Foreign Corporation” shall mean “controlled foreign corporation” as defined in the Tax Code.

“Copyright Licenses” shall mean any and all agreements granting any right in, to or under Copyrights (whether such Grantor is licensee or licensor thereunder) including, without limitation, each agreement referred to in Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time).

“Copyrights” shall mean all United States, state and foreign copyrights, including but not limited to copyrights in software and databases, and all Mask Works (as defined under 17 U.S.C. 901 of the U.S. Copyright Act), whether registered or unregistered, and, with respect to any and all of the foregoing: (i) all registrations and applications therefor including, without limitation, the applications referred to in Schedule IV attached hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time), (ii) all extensions and renewals thereof, (iii) all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world, (iv) all rights to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof, (v) all licenses, claims, damages and proceeds of suit arising therefrom, and (vi) all payments and rights to payments arising out of the sale, lease, license, assignment, or other disposition thereof.

“Deposit Account” shall mean all “deposit accounts” as defined in the UCC.

“Documents” shall mean all “documents” as defined in the UCC.

“Documents Evidencing Goods” shall mean all Documents evidencing, representing or issued in connection with Goods.

“Equipment” shall mean all “equipment” as defined in the UCC, including, without limitation, Fixtures.

“Event of Default” shall mean an “Event of Default” as defined in any Senior Secured Debt Document.

“Excluded Collateral” is defined in Section 2(b).

“Fixtures” shall mean all “fixtures” as defined in the UCC.

“General Intangibles” shall mean all “general intangibles” as defined in the UCC.

“Goods” shall mean all “goods” as defined in the UCC, including, without limitation, all Inventory, Equipment, Documents Evidencing Goods, Fixtures and Software Embedded In Goods.

“Governmental Authority” shall mean any federal, state, local or foreign court or governmental agency, authority, instrumentality or regulatory authority.

“Grantors” shall mean collectively, and “Grantor” means each of (a) as of the date hereof, First Quality Baby Products, LLC, First Quality Retail Services, LLC, First Quality Products, Inc., First Quality Hygienic, Inc., First Quality Nonwovens, Inc., First Quality Tissue, LLC, First Quality Enterprises, Inc., First Quality International, Inc., Nutek Disposables,

Inc., First Quality Water & Beverage, LLC, Paragon Trade Brands, Inc., PTB Acquisition Sub, Inc., PTB Holdings, Inc., Private Products, Inc. and Tyco Healthcare Retail Group GPS and (b) at any time thereafter, each other Person that shall become a Grantor hereunder pursuant to the relevant provision of the respective Senior Secured Debt Documents, in each case so long as such entity shall remain a Grantor hereunder.

“Instruments” shall mean all “instruments” as defined in the UCC.

“Insurance” shall mean (i) all insurance policies covering any or all of the Collateral (regardless of whether the Collateral Agent is the loss payee thereof) and (ii) any key man life insurance policies.

“Intellectual Property” shall mean, collectively, the Copyrights, the Copyright Licenses, the Patents, the Patent Licenses, the Trademarks, the Trademark Licenses, the Trade Secrets, and the Trade Secret Licenses.

“Intellectual Property Licenses” shall mean, collectively, the Copyright Licenses, Patent Licenses, Trademark Licenses, and Trade Secret Licenses.

“Intercreditor Agreement” is defined in the Recitals.

“Internal Revenue Code” shall mean the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended to the date hereof and from time to time hereafter, and any successor statute.

“Inventory” shall mean all “inventory” as defined in the UCC.

“Investment Accounts” shall mean the Securities Accounts, Commodities Accounts and Deposit Accounts.

“Investment Related Property” shall mean (a) all “investment property” and “financial assets” (as such terms are defined in the UCC) and (b) all of the following (regardless of whether classified as investment property under the UCC): all (i) Pledged Equity Interests, (ii) Pledged Debt and (iii) the Investment Accounts.

“Issuing Bank” is defined in the Revolving Credit Agreement.

“JPMCB” is defined in the Recitals.

“Letter of Credit” is defined in the Revolving Credit Agreement.

“Letter of Credit Right” shall mean “letter-of-credit right” as defined in the UCC.

“Material Adverse Effect” shall mean a material adverse effect on (a) the business, operations, results of operations, assets, liabilities or financial condition of the Grantors, taken as a whole, (b) the Collateral taken as a whole, or (c) the ability of the Grantors to perform their respective obligations under any Senior Secured Debt Documents.

“Material Contract” shall mean any contract or other arrangement to which any Grantor is a party for which breach, nonperformance, cancellation or failure to renew could reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect.

“Money” shall mean “money” as defined in the UCC.

“Patent Licenses” shall mean all agreements granting any right in, to, or under Patents (whether such Grantor is licensee or licensor thereunder) including without limitation, each agreement referred to in Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time).

“Patents” shall mean all patents and patent applications, including without limitation, the inventions and improvements described and claimed therein, and those patents listed on Schedule IV, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and (a) the reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part, thereof, (b) all income, royalties, damages and payments now and thereafter due and/or payable under and with respect thereto, including, without limitation, damages and payments for past, present, or future infringements thereof, (c) the right to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof, and (d) all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world.

“Payment Intangible” shall mean all “payment intangibles” as defined in the UCC.

“Permitted Liens” shall mean Liens permitted under the Senior Secured Debt Documents.

“Pledged Alternative Equity Interests” shall mean all participation or other interests in any equity or profits of any business entity and the certificates, if any, representing such interests all dividends, distributions, cash, warrants, rights, options, instruments, securities and other property or proceeds from time to time received, receivable or otherwise distributed in respect of or in exchange for any or all of such interests and any other warrant, right or option to acquire any of the foregoing; provided, however, that Pledged Alternative Equity Interests shall not include any Pledged Stock, Pledged Partnership Interests, Pledged LLC Interests and Pledged Trust Interests.

“Pledged Debt” shall mean all indebtedness for borrowed money owed to any Grantor, whether or not evidenced by any instrument or promissory note, including, without limitation, all indebtedness described on Schedule III hereto under the heading “Pledged Debt” (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time), all monetary obligations owing to any Grantor from any other Grantor the instruments evidencing any of the foregoing, and all interest, cash, instruments and other property or proceeds from time to time received, receivable or otherwise distributed in respect of or in exchange for any or all of the foregoing.

“Pledged Equity Interests” shall mean all Pledged Stock, Pledged LLC Interests, Pledged Partnership Interests, Pledged Trust Interests and Pledged Alternative Equity Interests.

“Pledged LLC Interests” shall mean all interests in any limited liability company owned by a Grantor including, without limitation, all limited liability company interests listed on Schedule III hereto under the heading “Pledged LLC Interests” (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time) and the certificates, if any, representing such limited liability company interests and any interest of such Grantor on the books and records of such limited liability company or on the books and records of any securities intermediary pertaining to such interest and all dividends, distributions, cash, warrants, rights, options, instruments, securities and other property or proceeds from time to time received,

receivable or otherwise distributed in respect of or in exchange for any or all of such limited liability company interests and any other warrant, right or option to acquire any of the foregoing.

“Pledged Partnership Interests” shall mean all interests in any general partnership, limited partnership, limited liability partnership or other partnership owned by a Grantor including, without limitation, all partnership interests listed on Schedule III hereto under the heading “Pledged Partnership Interests” (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time) and the certificates, if any, representing such partnership interests and any interest of such Grantor on the books and records of such partnership or on the books and records of any securities intermediary pertaining to such interest and all dividends, distributions, cash, warrants, rights, options, instruments, securities and other property or proceeds from time to time received, receivable or otherwise distributed in respect of or in exchange for any or all of such partnership interests and any other warrant, right or option to acquire any of the foregoing.

“Pledged Stock” shall mean all shares of capital stock owned by such Grantor, including, without limitation, all shares of capital stock described on Schedule III hereto under the heading “Pledged Stock” (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time), and the certificates, if any, representing such shares and any interest of such Grantor in the entries on the books of the issuer of such shares or on the books of any securities intermediary pertaining to such shares, and all dividends, distributions, cash, warrants, rights, options, instruments, securities and other property or proceeds from time to time received, receivable or otherwise distributed in respect of or in exchange for any or all of such shares and any other warrant, right or option to acquire any of the foregoing.

“Pledged Trust Interests” shall mean all interests in a Delaware business trust or other trust owned by a Grantor including, without limitation, all trust interests listed on Schedule III hereto under the heading “Pledged Trust Interests” (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time) and the certificates, if any, representing such trust interests and any interest of such Grantor on the books and records of such trust or on the books and records of any securities intermediary pertaining to such interest and all dividends, distributions, cash, warrants, rights, options, instruments, securities and other property or proceeds from time to time received, receivable or otherwise distributed in respect of or in exchange for any or all of such trust interests and any other warrant, right or option to acquire any of the foregoing.

“Proceeds” shall mean (i) all “proceeds” as defined in the UCC, (ii) payments or distributions made with respect to any Investment Related Property and (iii) whatever is receivable or received when Collateral or proceeds are sold, leased, licensed, exchanged, collected or otherwise disposed of, whether such disposition is voluntary or involuntary.

“Record” shall mean all “records” as defined in the UCC.

“Representation Date” shall mean (i) the date hereof and, if different, the Restatement Effective Date and (ii) each other date on which any Grantor shall be deemed to have ratified, confirmed or made a representation under any Senior Secured Debt Documents.

“Restatement Effective Date” shall mean the date of this Agreement.

“Revolver Administrative Agent” is defined in the Recitals.

“Revolver Lenders” is defined in the Recitals.

“Revolving Credit Agreement” is defined in the Recitals.

“Secured Obligations” shall mean the “Obligations” (as such term is defined in the Intercreditor Agreement) of each Grantor and each of its successors and assigns; provided, however, that the security granted by Nutek hereunder shall secure only the obligations of Nutek as limited as set forth in the Intercreditor Agreement.

“Secured Party” shall mean, collectively, the Revolver Lenders, the Revolver Administrative Agent, the 2004 Noteholders, the Term Loan Lenders, the Term Administrative Agent, the 2008 Noteholders, any Additional Secured Debt Holder, and any other holder from time to time of any Secured Obligations.

“Securities” shall mean any stock, shares, partnership interests, voting trust certificates, certificates of interest or participation in any profit-sharing agreement or arrangement, options, warrants, bonds, debentures, notes, or other evidences of indebtedness, secured or unsecured, convertible, subordinated or otherwise, or in general any instruments commonly known as “securities” or any certificates of interest, shares or participations in temporary or interim certificates for the purchase or acquisition of, or any right to subscribe to, purchase or acquire, any of the foregoing.

“Securities Accounts” (i) shall mean all “securities accounts” as defined in the UCC and (ii) shall include, without limitation, all of the accounts listed on Schedule III hereto under the heading “Securities Accounts” (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time).

“Software Embedded in Goods” shall mean, with respect to any Goods, any computer program embedded in Goods and any supporting information provided in connection with a transaction relating to the program if (i) the program is associated with the Goods in such a manner that it customarily is considered part of the Goods or (ii) by becoming the owner of the Goods a person acquires a right to use the program in connection with the Goods.

“State” shall mean a State of the United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, or any territory or insular possession subject to the jurisdiction of the United States.

“Supporting Obligation” shall mean all “supporting obligations” as defined in the UCC.

“Tax Code” shall mean the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time.

“Term Loan Administrative Agent” is defined in the Recitals.

“Term Loan Agreement” shall have the meaning set forth in the Recitals.

“Term Loan Lenders” is defined in the Recitals.

“Trade Secret Licenses” shall mean any and all agreements granting any right in or to Trade Secrets (whether such Grantor is licensee or licensor thereunder) including, without limitation, each agreement referred to in Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time).

“Trade Secrets” shall mean all trade secrets and all other confidential or proprietary information and know-how, whether or not reduced to a writing or other tangible form, including with respect to any and all of the foregoing: (i) all documents and things embodying, incorporating, or referring in any way thereto, (ii) all rights to sue for past, present and future infringement thereof, (iii) all licenses, claims, damages, and proceeds of suit arising therefrom, and (iv) all payments and rights to payments arising out of the sale, lease, license, assignment, or other dispositions thereof.

“Trademark Licenses” shall mean any and all agreements granting any right in or to Trademarks (whether such Grantor is licensee or licensor thereunder) including, without limitation, each agreement referred to in Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time).

“Trademarks” shall mean all service marks, trademarks, service mark and trademark registrations, trade names, and trademark and service mark applications, including, without limitation, the service mark and trademark registrations and applications listed on Schedule IV attached hereto and made a part hereof, but not including Excluded Collateral even if listed on Schedule IV and (a) the goodwill of the business connected with the use thereof and symbolized thereby, (b) all renewals thereof, (c) all income, royalties, damages and payments now and hereafter due and/or payable with respect thereto, including without limitation, damages and payments for past, present, or future infringements thereof, (d) the right to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof, and (e) all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world.

“2004 Administrative Agent” is defined in the Recitals.

“2004 Collateral Agent” is defined in the Recitals.

“2004 Credit Agreement” is defined in the Recitals.

“2004 Intercreditor Agreement” is defined in the Recitals.

“2004 Noteholders” is defined in the Recitals.

“2004 Note Purchase Agreement” is defined in the Recitals.

(b) Interpretation. References to “Sections,” “Annexes” and “Schedules” shall be to Sections, Annexes and Schedules, as the case may be, of this Agreement unless otherwise specifically provided. Section headings in this Agreement are included herein for convenience of reference only and shall not constitute a part of this Agreement for any other purpose or be given any substantive effect. Any of the terms defined herein may, unless the context otherwise requires, be used in the singular or the plural, depending on the reference. The use herein of the word “include” or “including”, when following any general statement, term or matter, shall not be construed to limit such statement, term or matter to the specific items or matters set forth immediately following such word or to similar items or matters, whether or not nonlimiting language (such as “without limitation” or “but not limited to” or words of similar import) is used with reference thereto, but rather shall be deemed to refer to all other items or matters that fall within the broadest possible scope of such general statement, term or matter. If any conflict or inconsistency exists between this Agreement and the Intercreditor Agreement, the Intercreditor Agreement shall govern. All references herein to provisions of the UCC shall include all successor provisions under any subsequent version or amendment to any Article of the UCC.

2. GRANT OF SECURITY.

(a) Grant of Security. Each Grantor party to the 2007 Security Agreement hereby confirms that the security interests granted to the Collateral Agent pursuant to the 2007 Security Agreement continue to secure the Secured Obligations evidenced by the Revolving Credit Agreement, the 2004 Note Purchase Agreement and the 2004 Notes to the extent such obligations are outstanding as of the date hereof and each Grantor, further, hereby grants to the Collateral Agent, for the benefit of the Secured Parties in accordance with the terms of the Intercreditor Agreement, a security interest in and continuing lien on all of such Grantor’s right, title and interest in, to and under all personal property of such Grantor including, but not limited to the following, in each case whether now owned or existing or hereafter acquired or arising and wherever located:

- (i) Accounts;
- (ii) Chattel Paper;
- (iii) Documents;
- (iv) General Intangibles;

(v) Goods (including Inventory, Equipment, Documents Evidencing Goods, Fixtures and Software Embedded in Goods);

(vi) Insurance;

(vii) Intellectual Property;

(viii) Investment Related Property;

(ix) Letter of Credit Rights;

(x) Money;

(xi) Commercial Tort Claims;

(xii) Collateral Records, Collateral Support, Records, and Supporting Obligations relating to any of the foregoing; and

(xiii) to the extent not otherwise included above, all Proceeds, products, accessions, rents and profits of or in respect of any of the foregoing.

(b) Excluded Collateral. The security interest granted under Section 2(a) hereof shall not attach to the following collateral (all such Collateral, the “Excluded Collateral”): (a) any lease, license, contract, property rights or agreement to which each Grantor is a party or any of its rights or interests thereunder if the grant of such security interest shall constitute or result in (i) the abandonment, invalidation or unenforceability of any right, title or interest of any Grantor therein or (ii) in a breach or termination pursuant to the terms of, or a default under, any such lease, license, contract property rights or agreement (other than to the extent that any such term would be rendered ineffective pursuant to Sections 9-406, 9-407, 9-408 or 9-409 of the UCC (or any successor provision or provisions) of any relevant jurisdiction or any other applicable law (including the Bankruptcy Code) or principles of equity); (b) any of the outstanding equity interests of a Controlled Foreign Corporation in excess of 65% of the voting power of all classes of equity interests of such Controlled Foreign Corporation entitled to vote or any outstanding equity interests in an entity that is treated as disregarded as an entity separate from its owner for U.S. federal income tax purposes if such entity owns in excess of 65% of the voting power of all classes of equity interests of a Controlled Foreign Corporation; (c) all equity interests of SN7117, Inc., a Delaware corporation, First Quality Falcon, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company and each other Aircraft Financing Subsidiary; and (d) Trademark applications filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark office (the “PTO”) on the basis of the Grantor’s intent to use such Trademark(s) unless and until evidence of the Grantor’s use in commerce (within the meaning of The Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1051 et seq.) thereof has been filed in the PTO.

3. SECURITY FOR OBLIGATIONS.

(a) Security for Obligations. This Agreement secures, and the Collateral is collateral security for, the prompt and complete payment and performance in full when due, whether at stated maturity, by required prepayment, declaration, acceleration, demand or otherwise (including the payment of amounts that would become due but for the operation of the automatic stay under Section 362(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §362(a) (and any successor provision thereof)), of all Secured Obligations.

(b) Continuing Liability under Collateral. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, (i) each Grantor shall remain liable for all obligations under the Collateral and nothing contained herein is intended or shall be a delegation of duties to the Collateral Agent or any Secured Party, (ii) each Grantor shall remain liable under each of the agreements included in the Collateral, to perform all of the obligations undertaken by it thereunder all in accordance with and pursuant to the terms and provisions thereof and neither the Collateral Agent nor any Secured Party shall have any obligation or liability under any of such agreements by reason of or arising out of this Agreement or any other document related thereto nor shall the Collateral Agent nor any Secured Party have any obligation to make any inquiry as to the nature or sufficiency of any payment received by it or have any obligation to take any action to collect or enforce any rights under any agreement included in the Collateral, and (iii) the exercise by the Collateral Agent of any of its rights hereunder shall not release any Grantor from any of its duties or obligations under the contracts and agreements included in the Collateral.

4. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES AND COVENANTS.

(a) Generally.

(i) Representations and Warranties. Each Grantor hereby represents and warrants, on each Representation Date, that:

1. the execution and delivery of this Agreement by such Grantor and the performance by it of its obligations under this Agreement are within its corporate or other powers and have been duly authorized by all necessary corporate or other action;

2. upon the filing of all UCC financing statements naming each Grantor as “debtor” and the Collateral Agent as “secured party” and describing the Collateral in the filing offices set forth opposite such Grantor’s name on Schedule I(5) hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time), the security interests granted to the Collateral Agent hereunder constitute valid and perfected first priority Liens (subject in the case of priority only to Permitted Liens); provided, however, that the recordation of this Agreement in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office and U.S. Copyright Office, as applicable, may be necessary to perfect the security interest of the Collateral Agent in U.S. Intellectual Property included in the Collateral which is the subject of registrations and applications, and any registrations and applications for U.S. Intellectual Property that are acquired by a Grantor after the date hereof in order to perfect the Collateral Agent’s lien therein; and the taking of actions outside the United States may be required in order to perfect the Collateral Agent’s lien in Intellectual Property included in the Collateral which is protected under non-U.S. law;

3. other than the financing statements filed in favor of the Collateral Agent, no effective UCC financing statement, fixture filing or other instrument similar in effect under any applicable law covering all or any part of the Collateral is on file in any filing or recording office except for (x) financing statements for which proper termination statements have been delivered to the Collateral Agent for filing and (y) financing statements filed in connection with Permitted Liens;

4. no authorization, approval or other action by, and no notice to or filing with, any Governmental Authority or regulatory body is required for either (i) the pledge or grant by any Grantor of the Liens purported to be created in favor of the Collateral

Agent hereunder or (ii) the exercise by the Collateral Agent of any rights or remedies in respect of any Collateral (whether specifically granted or created hereunder or created or provided for by applicable law), except (A) for the filings contemplated by clause (2) above and (B) as may be required, in connection with the disposition of any Investment Related Property, by laws generally affecting the offering and sale of Securities and as may be required under federal laws pertaining to Intellectual Property;

5. all actions and consents, including all filings, notices, registrations and recordings necessary or desirable for the exercise by the Collateral Agent of the voting or other rights provided for in this Agreement or the exercise of remedies in respect of the Collateral have been made or obtained, except for (i) the recording of the security interest in the applicable Intellectual Property registries with respect to issued Patents and registrations and applications for other U.S. Intellectual Property included in the Collateral and (ii) the taking of actions outside the United States that may be required to perfect the Collateral Agent's lien in Intellectual Property included in the Collateral which is protected under non-U.S. law and; provided, further, that the exercise of remedies with respect to issued Patents, and registrations and applications for any Intellectual Property included in the Collateral may require additional recordings with or notice to the applicable Intellectual Property registries;

6. it has indicated on Schedule I(1) hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time): (w) the type of organization of such Grantor, (x) the jurisdiction of organization of such Grantor, (y) its organizational identification number and (z) the jurisdiction where the chief executive office or its sole place of business is located;

7. the full legal name of such Grantor is as set forth on Schedule I(1) hereto and does not do, business under any other name (including any trade-name or fictitious business name) except for those names set forth on Schedule I(2) hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time);

8. except as provided on Schedule I(3) hereto, it has not changed its name, jurisdiction of organization, chief executive office or sole place of business or its corporate structure by merger, consolidation or change in corporate form or otherwise within the past five years; and

9. all information supplied by it with respect to any of the Collateral (in each case taken as a whole with respect to any particular Collateral) is accurate and complete in all material respects.

(ii) Covenants and Agreements. Each Grantor hereby covenants and agrees that:

1. it shall defend the Collateral against all Persons at any time claiming any interest therein;

2. it shall not use or permit any Collateral to be used in violation of any policy of insurance covering the Collateral where such violation could reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect; and

3. it shall not change such Grantor's name, identity or corporate structure by merger, consolidation or change in corporate form, sole place of business,

chief executive office, type of organization or jurisdiction of organization or establish any trade names unless it shall have notified the Collateral Agent in writing at least 30 days prior (other than Subsidiaries of Retail Services, for which notice shall be given immediately after such change) to any such change or establishment, identifying such new proposed name, identity, corporate structure, sole place of business, chief executive office, jurisdiction of organization or trade name and providing such other information in connection therewith as the Collateral Agent may reasonably request.

(b) Equipment and Inventory.

(i) Representations and Warranties. Each Grantor represents and warrants, on each Representation Date, that all of the Equipment and Inventory included in the Collateral is kept at the locations specified in Schedule II hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time).

(c) Intellectual Property.

(i) Representations and Warranties. Except as disclosed in Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time), each Grantor hereby represents and warrants, on each Representation Date, that:

1. Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time) sets forth a true and complete list of all U.S. federal and state registrations of and applications for Patents, Trademarks, and Copyrights owned by each Grantor;

2. all issued Patents and other registrations and applications for other Intellectual Property included in the Collateral are standing in the name of each Grantor;

3. it is the sole and exclusive owner of the entire right, title, and interest in and to all Intellectual Property on Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time), and owns or has the valid right to use all other material Intellectual Property used in or necessary to conduct its business free and clear of all Liens, claims, encumbrances and material licenses, granted by such Grantor, except for Permitted Liens and Intellectual Property Licenses which are set forth on Schedule IV hereto (as such schedule may be amended or supplemented from time to time);

4. each Grantor shall, other than where failure to do so would not result in a Material Adverse Effect, maintain and protect its material Intellectual Property;

5. the Grantors will, if requested by the Collateral Agent upon and during the continuation of an Event of Default, at the Grantors' cost and expense, (a) furnish the Collateral Agent with evidence reasonably satisfactory to the Collateral Agent that all actions required to be taken under this Agreement and the Credit Agreement necessary to maintain and protect each item of Intellectual Property owned by any Grantor have been taken in a timely manner; and (b) execute and deliver to the Collateral Agent an agreement permitting the Collateral Agent to exercise all of each Grantor's rights in, to and under any item of Intellectual Property owned by any Grantor.

(d) Commercial Tort Claims.

(i) The Grantors shall promptly notify the Collateral Agent of each Commercial Tort Claim from time to time in favor of any Grantor. The Grantors authorize the amendment of Schedule V hereto as necessary from time to time to reflect the correct status of the Grantors' Commercial Tort Claims.

(ii) Each amendment to Schedule V adding Commercial Tort Claims thereto shall constitute a contemporaneous grant by the Grantors to the Collateral Agent of a security interest in all of the Grantors' rights and interests in such Commercial Tort Claims.

(e) Account Warranties. The Grantors will, if requested by the Collateral Agent:

1. furnish to the Collateral Agent all information received by any Grantor affecting the financial standing of any account debtor whose account or contract right has been specifically assigned to the Collateral Agent;

2. immediately notify the Collateral Agent if more than 5% of its Accounts arise out of contracts with the United States or any department, agency or instrumentality thereof, and execute any instruments and take any steps required by the Collateral Agent in order that all monies due and to become due under such contract shall be assigned to the Collateral Agent and notice thereof given to the Government under the Federal Assignment of Claims Act; and

3. deliver to the Collateral Agent, with appropriate endorsement or assignment, any Instrument or Chattel Paper representing an Account or contract right.

(i) During the existence and continuation of an Event of Default, each Grantor will, if requested by the Collateral Agent:

1. give the Collateral Agent assignments, in form acceptable to the Collateral Agent, of specific Accounts or groups of Accounts and monies due and to become due under specific contracts and specific General Intangibles;

2. furnish to the Collateral Agent a copy, with such duplicate copies as the Collateral Agent may request, of the invoice applicable to each Account specifically assigned to the Collateral Agent or arising out of a contract right, bearing a statement that such Account has been assigned to the Collateral Agent and such additional statements as the Collateral Agent may require; (a) mark its records evidencing its Accounts in a manner satisfactory to the Collateral Agent so as to show which Accounts have been assigned to the Collateral Agent; (b) furnish to the Collateral Agent satisfactory evidence of the shipment and receipt of any goods specified by the Collateral Agent and the performance of any services or obligations covered by accounts or contracts in which the Collateral Agent has a Lien; (c) give the Collateral Agent such financial statements, reports, certificates, lists of purchasers (showing names, addresses, and amounts owing) and other data concerning its Accounts, contracts, collections, Inventory, General Intangibles and other matters as the Collateral Agent may from time to time specify; (d) segregate cash proceeds of Collateral so that they may be identified readily, and deliver the same to the Collateral Agent at such time or times and in such manner and form as the Collateral Agent may direct; (e) furnish such witnesses as may be necessary to establish legal proceed of the Collateral, or Records relating to the Collateral; and (f) use its best efforts to obtain from any owner, encumbrancer or other person having an interest in the property

where any Collateral is located, written consent to the Collateral Agent's removal of the Collateral therefrom, without liability on the part of the Collateral Agent or any other Secured Party to such owner, encumbrancer or other person, or from any such owner, encumbrancer or other person such waivers of any interest in the Collateral as the Collateral Agent may require.

(f) Insurance. The Grantors shall cause the Collateral Agent to be named loss payee (with a lender's loss payable endorsement) with respect to all personal property, and additional insured with respect to all liability insurance, as its interests may appear with 30 days' notice to be given the Collateral Agent by the insurance carrier prior to cancellation or material modification of such insurance coverage.

The Grantors shall cause to be delivered to the Collateral Agent the insurance policies and all endorsements thereto or in the alternative, evidence of insurance utilizing a current ACORD 27 certificate and at least 30 business days prior to the expiration of any such insurance, additional policies or duplicates thereof or in the alternative, evidence of insurance utilizing a current ACORD 27 certificate confirming the renewal of such insurance and payment of the premiums therefor. The Grantors shall direct all insurers that in the event of any loss thereunder or the cancellation of any insurance policy, the insurers shall make payments for such loss and pay all return or unearned premiums directly to the Collateral Agent and not to the Grantors and the Collateral Agent jointly.

In the event of any loss, the Grantors will give the Collateral Agent immediate notice thereof and the Collateral Agent may make proof of loss whether the same is done by the Grantors. The Collateral Agent is granted a power of attorney by each Grantor with full power of substitution to file any proof of loss in any Grantor's or the Collateral Agent's name, to endorse any Grantor's name on any check, draft or other instrument evidencing insurance proceeds, and to take any action or sign any document to pursue any insurance loss claim. Such power being coupled with an interest is irrevocable.

In the event of any loss, the Collateral Agent shall (a) retain and apply all or any part of the insurance proceeds, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Intercreditor Agreement, to the payment of the Secured Obligations, or (b) if the relevant Grantor shall have exercised its right to repair or replace the affected property pursuant to the relevant Senior Secured Debt Document, disburse all or any part of such insurance proceeds to or for the benefit of a Grantor for the purpose of repairing or replacing Collateral after receiving proof satisfactory to the Collateral Agent of such repair or replacement, in either case without waiving or impairing the Secured Obligations or any provision of this Agreement. Any deficiency thereon shall be paid by the Grantors to the Collateral Agent upon demand. No Grantor shall take out any insurance without having the Collateral Agent named as loss payee or additional insured thereon. The Grantors shall bear the full risk of loss from any loss of any nature whatsoever with respect to the Collateral.

5. FURTHER ASSURANCES. Each Grantor agrees that from time to time, at the expense of such Grantor, that it shall promptly Authenticate, execute and deliver all further instruments and documents, and take all further action, that may be necessary or reasonably desirable, or that the Collateral Agent may reasonably request, in order to create and/or maintain the validity, perfection or priority of and protect any security interest granted or purported to be granted hereby or to enable the Collateral Agent to exercise and enforce its rights and remedies hereunder with respect to any Collateral. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, each Grantor shall:

(a) file such financing or continuation statements, or amendments thereto, and execute and deliver such other agreements, instruments, endorsements, powers of attorney or notices, as may be necessary or desirable, or as the Collateral Agent may reasonably request, in order to perfect and preserve the security interests granted or purported to be granted hereby;

(b) at the Collateral Agent's request, appear in and defend any action or proceeding that may affect such Grantor's title to or the Collateral Agent's security interest in all or any part of the Collateral;

(c) authorize the Collateral Agent to take all steps it deems reasonably necessary to maintain and preserve the Collateral, consistent with the Grantor's obligations to do so hereunder, including, with respect to Intellectual Property included in the Collateral, the making of additional filings, the payment of maintenance fees, and the defense of challenges to the Grantor's title or validity, all at the Grantor's expense; and

(d) each Grantor hereby authorizes the filing of any financing statements or continuation statements, and amendments to financing statements, or any similar document (other than the Senior Secured Debt Documents) in any jurisdictions and with any filing offices as the Collateral Agent may determine, in its sole discretion, are necessary or advisable to perfect the security interest granted to the Collateral Agent herein. Such financing statements may describe the Collateral in the same manner as described herein or may contain an indication or description of collateral that describes such property in any other manner as the Collateral Agent may determine, in its sole discretion, is necessary, advisable or prudent to ensure the perfection of the security interest in the Collateral granted to the Collateral Agent herein, including, without limitation, describing such property as "all assets" or "all personal property", whether now owned or hereafter acquired.

6. COLLATERAL AGENT APPOINTED ATTORNEY-IN-FACT.

(a) Power of Attorney. Each Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints (during the tenure of this Agreement) the Collateral Agent (such appointment being coupled with an interest) as such Grantor's attorney-in-fact, with full authority in the place and stead of such Grantor and in the name of such Grantor, the Collateral Agent or otherwise, from time to time in the Collateral Agent's discretion to take any action and to execute any instrument that the Collateral Agent may deem reasonably necessary or advisable to accomplish the purposes of this Agreement, including, without limitation, the following:

(i) to prepare, sign, and file for recordation in any Intellectual Property registry, appropriate evidence of the Lien and security interest granted herein in the Intellectual Property in the name of such Grantor as assignor or pledgor;

(ii) to take or cause to be taken all actions necessary to perform or comply or cause performance or compliance with the terms of this Agreement, including, without limitation, access to pay or discharge taxes or Liens (other than Permitted Liens) levied or placed upon or threatened against the Collateral, the legality or validity thereof and the amounts necessary to discharge the same to be determined by the Collateral Agent in its sole discretion, any such payments made by the Collateral Agent to become obligations of such Grantor to the Collateral Agent, due and payable immediately without demand;

(iii) file any proof of loss in the Grantor's or the Collateral Agent's name, to endorse the Grantor's name on any check, draft or other instrument evidencing insurance proceeds, and to take any action or sign any document to pursue any insurance loss claim; and

(iv) upon the occurrence and during the continuance of any Event of Default (and with or without judicial process);

1. to ask for, send notices with respect to, demand, collect, sue for, recover, compound, receive and give acquittance and receipts for moneys due and to become due under or in respect of any of the Collateral;

2. to receive, endorse and collect any drafts or other Instruments, Documents and Chattel Paper in connection with clause (1) above;

3. to file any claims or take any action or institute any proceedings that the Collateral Agent may deem necessary or desirable for the collection of any of the Collateral; and

4. to sell, transfer, assign, lease, license (on an exclusive or nonexclusive basis, to the extent the Grantor has the lawful right to do so), subject to licenses in effect as of the date of such assignment, grant or issuance, pledge, make any agreement with respect to or otherwise deal with any of the Collateral as fully and completely as though the Collateral Agent were the absolute owner thereof for all purposes, and to do, at the Collateral Agent's option, at any time or from time-to-time, all acts and things that the Collateral Agent deems reasonably necessary to protect, preserve, or realize upon the Collateral and the Collateral Agent's security interest therein as fully and effectively as such Grantor might do (including, without limitation, notifying the United States Postal Office to change the address for delivery of mail to the Grantors to an address as the Collateral Agent may designate).

(v) The powers conferred on the Collateral Agent hereunder are solely to protect its interest in the Collateral and the interests of the Secured Parties and shall not impose any duty upon it to exercise any such powers. Except for the exercise of reasonable care in the custody of any Collateral in its possession and the accounting for moneys actually received by it hereunder, the Collateral Agent shall have no duty as to any Collateral or as to the taking of any necessary steps to preserve rights against prior parties or any other rights pertaining to any Collateral. The Collateral Agent shall be deemed to have exercised reasonable care in the custody and preservation of Collateral in its possession if such Collateral is accorded treatment substantially equal to that which the Collateral Agent accords its own property. Neither the Collateral Agent nor any of its directors, officers, employees or agents shall be liable for failure to demand, collect or realize upon all or any part of the Collateral or for any delay in doing so or shall be under any obligation to sell or otherwise dispose of any Collateral upon the request of any Grantor or otherwise. If any Grantor fails to perform any agreement contained herein, the Collateral Agent may itself perform, or cause performance of, such agreement, and the expenses of the Collateral Agent incurred in connection therewith shall be payable by each Grantor under the Section in this Agreement relating to the payment of expenses.

7. REMEDIES.

(a) Generally.

(i) If any Event of Default shall have occurred and be continuing, the Collateral Agent may exercise in respect of the Collateral, in addition to all other rights and remedies provided for herein or otherwise available to it at law or in equity, all the rights and remedies of the Collateral Agent on default under the UCC (whether or not the UCC applies to the affected Collateral) to collect, enforce or satisfy any Secured Obligations then owing, whether by acceleration or otherwise, and also may pursue any of the following separately, successively or simultaneously:

1. enter onto the property where any Collateral is located and take possession thereof with or without judicial process and sell or dispose of the Collateral on such premises, without liability for rent, storage, utilities or other sums;

2. prior to the disposition of the Collateral, store, process, repair or recondition the Collateral or otherwise prepare the Collateral for disposition in any manner to the extent the Collateral Agent deems appropriate; provided that processed, reconditioned, or repaired products that are sold under the Grantor's Trademarks shall be of at least substantially comparable quality to the same products sold under such Trademarks at the time of the Event of Default, and shall, if applicable, be labeled as "reconditioned", or the like, to the extent required by law;

3. without notice, except as specified below or under the UCC, sell, assign, lease, license (on an exclusive or nonexclusive basis, to the extent the Grantor has the lawful right to do so), subject to licenses in effect as of the date of such assignment, grant or issuance, or otherwise dispose of the Collateral or any part thereof in one or more parcels at public or private sale, at any of the Collateral Agent's offices or elsewhere, for cash, on credit or for future delivery, at such time or times and at such price or prices and upon such other terms as the Collateral Agent may deem commercially reasonable; and

4. require the Grantors, at the Grantors' expense, to assemble all or any part of the Collateral and make it available to the Collateral Agent at any place designated by the Collateral Agent.

(ii) The Collateral Agent or any Secured Party may be the purchaser of any or all of the Collateral at any public or private (to the extent that portion of the Collateral being privately sold is of a kind that is customarily sold on a recognized market or the subject of widely distributed standard price quotations) sale in accordance with the UCC and the Collateral Agent, as collateral agent for and representative of the Secured Parties, shall be entitled, for the purpose of bidding and making settlement or payment of the purchase price for all or any portion of the Collateral sold at any such sale made in accordance with the UCC, to use and apply any of the Secured Obligations as a credit on account of the purchase price for any Collateral payable by the Collateral Agent at such sale. Each purchaser at any such sale shall hold the property sold absolutely free from any claim or right on the part of any Grantor, and each Grantor hereby waives (to the extent permitted by applicable law) all rights of redemption, stay and/or appraisal which it now has or may at any time in the future have under any rule of law or statute now existing or hereafter enacted. Each Grantor agrees that, to the extent notice of sale shall be required by law, at least five days notice to such Grantor of the time and place of any public sale or the time after which any private sale is to be made shall constitute reasonable notification (provided, however, if permitted by applicable law, any perishable Collateral which threatens to speedily decline in value or which is sold on a recognized market may be sold immediately by the Collateral Agent without notice to the Grantors). The Collateral Agent shall not be obligated

to make any sale of Collateral regardless of notice of sale having been given. The Collateral Agent may adjourn any public or private sale from time to time by announcement at the time and place fixed therefor, and such sale may, without further notice, be made at the time and place to which it was so adjourned. Each Grantor agrees that it would not be commercially unreasonable for the Collateral Agent to dispose of the Collateral or any portion thereof by using internet sites that provide for the auction of assets of the types included in the Collateral or that have the reasonable capability of doing so, or that match buyers and sellers of assets. Each Grantor hereby waives any claims against the Collateral Agent arising by reason of the fact that the price at which any Collateral may have been sold at such a private sale was less than the price which might have been obtained at a public sale, even if the Collateral Agent accepts the first offer received and does not offer such Collateral to more than one offeree. If the Proceeds of any sale or other disposition of the Collateral are insufficient to pay all the Secured Obligations, each Grantor shall be liable for the deficiency and the fees of any attorneys employed by the Collateral Agent to collect such deficiency.

(iii) The Collateral Agent may sell the Collateral without giving any warranties as to the Collateral. The Collateral Agent may specifically disclaim or modify any warranties of title or the like. This procedure will not be considered to adversely effect the commercial reasonableness of any sale of the Collateral.

(iv) The Collateral Agent shall have no obligation to marshal any of the Collateral.

The Grantors shall not resist or interfere with any of the above described actions.

(b) Application of Proceeds. All Proceeds received by the Collateral Agent in respect of any sale, any collection from, or other realization upon all or any part of the Collateral shall be applied in full or in part by the Collateral Agent against the Secured Obligations as provided in the Intercreditor Agreement.

(c) Sales on Credit. If the Collateral Agent sells any of the Collateral upon credit, the Grantors will be credited only with payments actually made by purchaser and received by the Collateral Agent and applied to the Secured Obligations. In the event the purchaser fails to pay for the Collateral, the Collateral Agent may resell the Collateral and the Grantors shall be credited with Proceeds of the sale.

8. CONTINUING SECURITY INTEREST; TRANSFER OF SECURED OBLIGATIONS.

This Agreement shall create a continuing security interest in the Collateral and shall remain in full force and effect until the payment in full of all Secured Obligations (other than Qualified Residual Obligations), the cancellation or termination of the commitments to extend credit under the Revolving Credit Agreement and any other contingent obligation included in the Secured Obligations (other than Qualified Residual Obligations), be binding upon each Grantor, its successors and assigns, and inure, together with the rights and remedies of the Collateral Agent hereunder, to the benefit of the Collateral Agent and its successors, transferees and assigns. Upon the payment in full of all Secured Obligations (other than Qualified Residual Obligations), the cancellation or termination of such commitments and any other contingent obligation included in the Secured Obligations (other than Qualified Residual Obligations), the security interest granted hereby shall terminate hereunder and of record and all rights to the Collateral shall revert and be deemed reassigned to the Grantors and all obligations of the

Grantors under the relevant Senior Secured Debt Documents shall terminate (other than such provisions of any of the Senior Secured Debt Document that expressly indicated as surviving termination of such Senior Secured Debt Document, which provisions shall survive and remain in full force and effect regardless of, in each case, (a) the repayment of the respective Secured Obligations thereunder (and, if applicable, the expiration or termination of the letters of credit and commitments to extend credit thereunder) and (b) the termination of this Agreement or any provision hereof). Upon any such termination, the Collateral Agent shall, at the Grantors' request and expense, execute and deliver to the Grantors such documents as the Grantors shall reasonably request to evidence such termination reversions and/or reassignment, without recourse, representation, or warranty of any kind.

9. MISCELLANEOUS.

(a) Successors and Assigns. All covenants and other agreements contained in this Agreement by or on behalf of any of the parties hereto bind and inure to the benefit of their respective successors and assigns (including, without limitation, any subsequent Secured Party) whether so expressed or not.

(b) Severability. Any provision of this Agreement that is prohibited or unenforceable in any jurisdiction shall, as to such jurisdiction, be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition or unenforceability without invalidating the remaining provisions hereof, and any such prohibition or unenforceability in any jurisdiction shall (to the full extent permitted by law) not invalidate or render unenforceable such provision in any other jurisdiction.

(c) Construction. Each covenant contained herein shall be construed (absent express provision to the contrary) as being independent of each other covenant contained herein, so that compliance with any one covenant shall not (absent such an express contrary provision) be deemed to excuse compliance with any other covenant. Where any provision herein refers to action to be taken by any Person, or which such Person is prohibited from taking, such provision shall be applicable whether such action is taken directly or indirectly by such Person.

(d) Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be an original but all of which together shall constitute one instrument. Each counterpart may consist of a number of copies hereof, each signed by less than all, but together signed by all, of the parties hereto.

(e) Governing Law. This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall be construed in accordance with and be governed by the law of the State of New York, without giving effect to principles of conflicts of laws thereof, except Sections 5-1401 and 5-1402 of the New York General Obligations Law.

(f) Amendment, etc. None of the terms and conditions of this Agreement may be changed, waived, modified or varied in any manner whatsoever unless in writing duly signed by the Grantors and the Collateral Agent (with appropriate direction from the requisite holders of the Secured Obligations as provided in the Intercreditor Agreement).

(g) Inconsistent Provisions. If any provision of this Agreement shall be inconsistent with, or contrary to, any provision in the Intercreditor Agreement, the provision in the Intercreditor Agreement shall be controlling, and shall supersede such inconsistent provision to the extent necessary to give full effect to all provisions contained in the Intercreditor Agreement.

(h) Addresses for Notices. All notices and communications provided for hereunder shall be in writing and sent (a) by facsimile if the sender on the same day sends a confirming copy of such notice by a recognized overnight delivery service (charges prepaid), or (b) by a recognized overnight delivery service (with charges prepaid).
