This TERMINATION AGREEMENT made as of the 1st day of July, 1998 by and between MELLON BANK, N.A., a national banking association with an address at 610 West Germantown Pike, Suite 200, Plymouth Meeting, PA 19462 ("Bank"), and NAMICO, INC., a Pennsylvania corporation with an address at 4601 Flat Rock Road, Philadelphia, PA 19127 ("Borrower").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on July 1, 1998, Borrower repaid to Bank all obligations of Borrower under the Loan Agreement, other than certain potential obligations of Borrower under letters of credit which have been separately collateralized; and
