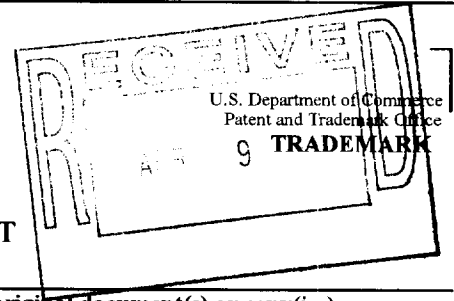

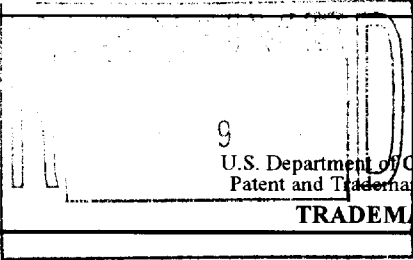

This RELEASE (TRADEMARK) is granted on this 31<sup>st</sup> day of

MARCH 1999 by Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., a national banking association, located at 420 Montgomery Street, San Francisco, California 94163 ("Assignor") as Administrative Lender for the Lenders under the Amended and Restated Revolving Credit and Term Loan Agreement, dated as of August 30, 1996 (the "Credit Agreement"), in favor of Favorite Brands International, Inc., a Delaware corporation, successor by merger to Sathers, Inc., a Delaware corporation (formerly known as SA Acquisition Corporation, a Delaware corporation), located at 2121 Waukegan Road, Suite 300, Bannockburn, Illinois 60015 ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, in connection with the Credit Agreement, Assignee executed and delivered to Assignor, for its benefit and the benefit of the Lenders (as defined in the Credit Agreement), a Guarantee Agreement, dated as of August 30, 1996 (the "Guaranty"), a Security Agreement, dated as of August 30, 1996 (the "Security Agreement"), and an Agreement (Trademark), dated as of August 30, 1996 (the "Trademark Security Agreement") in order to grant to the Assignor a continuing security interest in all of the Trademark Collateral (as defined

in the Trademark Security Agreement) including, but not limited to, the registered trademarks and trademark applications listed on Attachment I hereto;

WHEREAS, the Trademark Security Agreement was recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on September 12, 1996 at Reel 1501/Frame 04321 et. seq.;




