WHEREAS, NCS is desirous of acquiring said mark and the registration thereof.

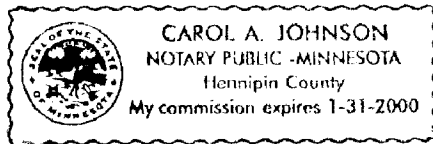
