

**TERMINATION OF SECURITY INTEREST
(TRADEMARKS ONLY)**

This TERMINATION OF SECURITY INTEREST, dated as of August 13, 1999, is made by FLEET NATIONAL BANK, a national banking association ("*Fleet*").

WHEREAS, Micrion Corporation, a Massachusetts corporation ("*Micrion*") and Fleet entered into a Supplemental Security Agreement dated as of July 31, 1997 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "*Security Agreement*"; terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the respective meanings provided for in the Security Agreement);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Security Agreement and a certain Security Agreement (Trademarks), dated as of July 31, 1997, Micrion granted to Fleet a security interest in substantially all of the assets of Micrion, including all right, title and interest of Micrion in, to and under all Trademarks and Pending Applications, then owned or thereafter acquired, including all proceeds therefrom;

WHEREAS, Micrion has satisfied all of the Obligations (as defined in the Loan Agreement) and Fleet has agreed to terminate and release its security interest in, and its right, title and interest in, to and under, all Trademarks and Pending Applications, including, without limitation the Patents identified on Schedule A attached hereto, the "*Collateral*", as herein provided; and

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration and pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Loan Agreement, Fleet hereby terminates and releases, and confirms the termination and release of its lien on and security interest in, and all of its right, title and interest in, to and under, the following, whether presently existing or hereafter arising or acquired:

A. Trademarks

1. each trademark, trademark registration and trademark registration application of Micrion, including, without limitation, the trademarks, trademark registrations and trademark registration applications referred to in Schedule A attached hereto;
2. each trademark license to which Micrion is a party, including, without limitation, each trademark license listed on Schedule A attached hereto;
3. all products and proceeds of the foregoing A1 and A2, including, without limitation, proceeds of insurance policies thereon.
