**RELEASE OF SECURITY INTERESTS IN TRADEMARKS**

This Release of Security Interests in Trademarks is granted and conveyed as of March 2, 2000 by First Union National Bank, a national banking association, both individually and as successor by merger to CoreStates Bank, N.A. and Meridian Bank, having an office at 1339 Chestnut Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19107 (collectively hereinafter referred to as "CoreStates"), in favor of Brotech Corp., a Delaware corporation, having its principal business address at 150 Monument Road, Suite 202, Bala Cynwyd, Pennsylvania 19004 ("Brotech").

WHEREAS, the records of the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("PTO") reflect that Brotech and Meridian Bank entered into a Trademark Security Assignment on June 18, 1993, under which Brotech granted to Meridian Bank an assignment of part of Brotech's interest in the trademarks listed on the attached Schedule A, any applications for federal registration or federal registrations therefor, and the goodwill associated therewith (the "Marks").

WHEREAS, the PTO recorded this security assignment and security agreement on July 30, 1993, at Trademark Reel 1009, Frame 0198;

WHEREAS, the records of the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("PTO") reflect that Brotech and CoreStates entered into an Amended and Restated Trademark Security Agreement on November 25, 1997, under which Brotech granted to CoreStates an assignment of part of Brotech's interest in the trademarks listed on the attached Schedule A, any applications for federal registration or federal registrations therefor, and the goodwill associated therewith (the "Marks").


WHEREAS, the PTO recorded this security assignment and security agreement on April 2, 1999, at Trademark Reel 1878, Frame 0901;

WHEREAS, Brotech has satisfied all of its outstanding obligations under the security agreements, and the parties seek to make a record of CoreStates' releases and reassignments to Brotech of any and all of their security interests in the Marks.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which the parties acknowledge, CoreStates hereby (1) releases, discharges, and relinquishes, as of ~~the~~ March 2, 2000, its security interests in the Marks, and (2) reassigns to Brotech, as of March 2, 2000, all right, title, and interest that CoreStates may have had in the Marks, including the goodwill associated therewith. CoreStates specifically acknowledges that the security interests are no longer effective, and that CoreStates does not own any rights to or have any ownership interest in the Marks.
