NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby assign unto Assignee all of Assignor’s rights, title, and interest in and to the Trademark and the registration therefor, together with the goodwill of the business in connection with which the Trademark is used and which is symbolized by the Trademark, throughout the world, along with the right to recover damages and profits for past, present, and future infringements thereof.

Assignor agrees to execute and deliver, at the request of the Assignee, all documents, instruments and assignments, and to perform any other reasonable acts the Assignee may require, in order to vest all of Assignor’s rights, title, and interest in and to the Trademark to the Assignee and to provide evidence to support any of the foregoing in the event such evidence is necessary to effectuate the assignment, to the extent such evidence is in the possession or control of Assignor.
