

ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment is effective as of May 22, 2000.

WHEREAS, Bibliostat.com Corporation (Formerly known as Management Dynamics, Inc. and hereinafter referred to as "Assignor"), a corporation of the State of Utah, having a principal office at 250 West Center Street, Suite 300, Provo, Utah 84601, has acquired through use and is the owner of all right, title, and interest in certain registered and unregistered trademarks and service marks (hereinafter referred to as the "marks")(an identification of such certain marks is attached hereto as Schedule A); and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of ten dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration paid to the Assignor by the Assignee, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, THE ASSIGNOR HEREBY ASSIGNS TO THE ASSIGNEE the entire right, title, and interest in and to the marks and the registrations therefor, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by and associated with each mark. Assignor also hereby transfers to Assignee a client list and telephone numbers of client contact persons and information regarding client buying habits, all of which relate to the goodwill of the business symbolized by and associated with each mark.

The Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and such officials in foreign countries as are duly authorized by their laws to register the marks, to issue any and all certificates of registration for the marks to the Assignee as the owner of the entire interest, for the sole use and benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives.

Assignor agrees that, if for any reason this assignment is deemed ineffective, Assignor will again assign the Marks, separately or together, to Assignee upon registration of the Marks in the United States Patent and Trademark Office.

This Assignment shall be binding upon Assignor's successors and assigns. This Assignment may be executed simultaneously in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and each of which shall constitute one and the same instrument for purposes of evidencing this Assignment.

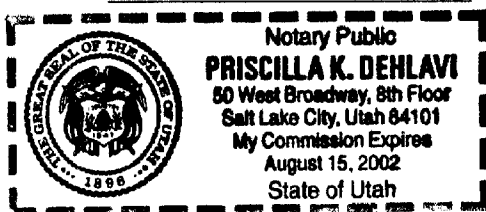
