

RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

Release dated September 24, 2001, from FLEET NATIONAL BANK, as Administrative Agent ("Agent"), to BALDWIN TECHNOLOGY COMPANY, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Owner").

Background

A. 
