**PARTIAL RELEASE AND DISCHARGE
OF SECURITY INTEREST IN TRADEMARKS, TRADEMARK APPLICATIONS AND
PATENT APPLICATION**

This Partial Release and Discharge of Security Interest in Trademarks and Patent Application (this "Release") is made and entered into as of the ____ day of July, 2002 (the "Release Date") by and among DEUTSCHE BANK TRUST COMPANY AMERICAS, a New York banking corporation f/k/a Bankers Trust Company, acting on its own behalf and as agent for the Lenders identified below ("Agent"), and is for the benefit of WEIDER NUTRITION INTERNATIONAL, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Releasee").

RECITALS:

A. By a certain Credit Agreement dated as of June 30, 2000 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, the "Credit Agreement") Agent, and certain lenders ("Lenders") extended credit and made other financial accommodations to Weider Nutrition Group, Inc., a Utah corporation ("Borrower").

B. Releasee is the parent company of Borrower and Releasee guaranteed Borrower's obligations under the Credit Agreement pursuant to the terms of a Guaranty dated as of June 30, 2000 in favor of Agent and Lenders (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Guaranty").

C. As security for Releasee's obligations under the Guaranty, Releasee granted to Agent, on its own behalf and as Agent for the Lenders certain security interests in and to certain trademarks, trademark applications and trademark registrations pursuant to the Credit Documents and that certain Trademark Security Agreement, dated on or about June 30, 2000, between Borrower and Agent (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, "the "Trademark Security Agreement").

D. As further security for Releasee's obligations under the Guaranty, Releasee granted to Agent, on its own behalf as Agent for the Lenders certain security interests in and to certain patents and patent applications and other intellectual property pursuant to the Credit Documents and that certain Patent Security Agreement, dated on or about June 30, 2000, between Borrower and Agent (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, the "Patent Security Agreement").

E. Borrower now desires to sell certain of its assets relating to its American Bottling and Beverage business (the "Business") and Releasee has requested that Agent release its security interest in certain intellectual property relating exclusively to the Business and described more specifically below as the Released Intellectual Property.

F. Agent, pursuant to this Release, will on behalf of itself and as agent for the Lenders, evidence its release of any and all security interests in and to the Released Intellectual Property.

RELEASE:

NOW, THEREFORE, in reliance on the above recitals for and in consideration of the premises, provisions and covenants as set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, Agent, by and for itself and as agent for and on behalf of the Lenders, hereby agrees as follows:

1. Release of Security Interests. Effective as of the Release Date, Agent, by and for itself and as agent for and on behalf of the Lenders, hereby irrevocably and forever releases and discharges from any and all liens, claims, security interests or other rights granted to the Agent and the Lenders pursuant to the Trademark Security Agreement and the Patent Security Agreement or any other agreement in, to and on (i) the trademarks, trademark applications and trademark registrations identified on Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference and (ii) the patent application identified on Schedule B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (together the intellectual property listed on Schedule A and Schedule B, the "Released Intellectual Property").


2. Worldwide Scope of Release. By this Release, Agent, by and for itself and as agent for and on behalf of the Lenders, intends to and hereby does terminate, release and discharge any and all rights, titles and interests, in any jurisdiction anywhere in the world, of Agent and/or the Lenders in and to the Released Intellectual Property.

3. Recordation of Release. The Agent understands and agrees that this Release may be recorded by or for Releasee with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office and with any other agency, office or authority in any jurisdiction.

4. Further Actions. Agent, for itself and as Agent for the Lenders, further agrees, at Releasee's expense, to execute any other documents and take any further action reasonably necessary in any state, country or jurisdiction that Releasee may reasonably require to effect the intent and purpose of this Release.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties have executed this Partial Release and Discharge of Security Interest in Trademarks and Patent Application as of the date above set forth.
