TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT - SHORT FORM

TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT dated December 6, 2002 made by WPC Brands, Inc., a Wisconsin corporation, having its principal place of business at 1 Repel Road, Jackson, Wisconsin 53037, (the "*Grantor*"), in favor of BANK OF AMERICA, N.A. (formerly known as NationsBank, N.A.) ("*Bank of America*"), having its principal place of business at Independence Center, 101 North Tryon Street, 15th Floor, NC1-001-15-04, Charlotte, North Carolina 28255, as the administrative agent and the collateral agent (together with any successor thereto appointed pursuant to Article VII of the Credit Agreement referred to below, the "*Grantee*") for the Lender Parties and the other Secured Parties (each as defined in the Credit Agreement).

United Industries Corporation is party to an Amended and Restated Credit Agreement dated as of March 24, 1999 (as further amended, supplemented or otherwise modified hereafter from time to time, the "*Credit Agreement*") with the banks, financial institutions and other institutional lenders from time to time party thereto, Bank of America, as Swing Line Bank and Initial Issuing Bank thereunder, Banc of America Securities LLC (formerly known as NationsBanc Montgomery Securities LLC) ("*BAS*") and Morgan Stanley Senior Funding, Inc. ("*MSSF*"), as Co-Arrangers therefor, Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce, as Documentation Agent therefor, MSSF, as Syndication Agent thereunder, BAS, as Lead Arranger and Book Manager therefor, and the Grantee. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the same meanings as specified therefor in the Credit Agreement or the Security Agreement referred to below.

In connection with the Credit Agreement, the Grantor and the Grantee entered into an Amended and Restated Security Agreement dated March 24, 1999 (as further amended, supplemented or otherwise modified hereafter from time to time, the "*Security Agreement*") with the other grantors party thereto, pursuant to which the Grantor has granted to the Grantee for the ratable benefit of the Secured Parties a lien on and security interest in, inter alia, all of the Grantor's rights, title, and interest in and to all Trademarks (as defined in the Security Agreement) of such Grantor, whether then owned or thereafter acquired or created by such Grantor, including, without limitation, the trademark applications and registrations therefor listed on Schedule A hereto (the "*Trademark Collateral*") and the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby.


The parties desire to record the Grantor's grant of the security interest in the Trademark Collateral to the Grantee with the United States Patent & Trademark Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Grantor hereby agrees with the Grantee for the ratable benefit of the Secured Parties as follows:

1. The Credit Agreement and Security Agreement and their terms and provisions are incorporated herein in their entirety.
2. The Grantor grants to the Grantee a security interest in all of its right, title, and interest in and to the Trademark Collateral and the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Trademark Collateral.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Grantor has caused this Trademark Security Agreement to be duly executed and delivered by its officer thereunto duly authorized, as of the date first written above.
