10. On February 6, 2002, DCV recorded a Security Interest, Reel/Frame 012551/0837 ("DCV Patent Security Agreement"), with the United States Patent and Trademark Office. The DCV Patent Security Agreement set forth DCV's security interest in the following United States Patent:

11. The debt set forth in the Underlying Agreement was satisfied in full.

12. Deponent has made a diligent search of the applicable records and has made various attempts to contact individuals that were formerly employees of DCV. Specifically, Deponent attempted to contact three former DCV employees by electronic mail, without response. Deponent further attempted to contact one former DCV employee by cell phone, however the cell phone number is no longer valid.

13. Deponent spoke with John P. Kirwin, a managing partner of Argosy Investment Partners II, L.P., a Pennsylvania limited partnership ("Argosy"). Argosy regularly did business with DCV and was also a party to the agreements at issue here (the Underlying Agreement, DCV Copyright Security Agreement, DCV Trademark Security Agreement, and DCV Patent Security Agreement). Mr. Kirwin stated that DCV is no longer in business and further indicated that he does not know the whereabouts of the former principals of DCV.

14. Upon information and belief, DCV is no longer in business.


15. Upon information and belief, DCV has no successor in interest.

17. This Affidavit is being made to demonstrate that neither DCV, nor any successor in interest, has a valid security interest in the foregoing intellectual property.


