**RELEASE AND TERMINATION OF ASSIGNMENT OF SECURITY
INTEREST IN PATENTS, COPYRIGHTS, TRADEMARKS AND LICENSES**

This RELEASE AND TERMINATION is made by CITIZENS BANK OF PENNSYLVANIA, a Pennsylvania state chartered bank, 525 William Penn Place, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15219 (hereinafter "CBP").

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, CBP hereby releases and terminates all rights as an assignee, secured party and power of attorney holder in and to the Patents, Copyrights, Trademarks and Goodwill and the Licenses and Proceeds. CBP further authorizes and requests that the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments, to note in the record, the termination and release of the security interest heretofore granted by Marlite to CBP with respect to the Patents, Copyrights, Trademarks and Goodwill associated therewith and the Licenses and Proceeds.
