**CONFIRMATORY TERMINATION AND RELEASE
OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

This **CONFIRMATORY TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY** (this "Release") is effective as of August 3, 2012 by The CIT Group/Commercial Services, Inc., a New York corporation having an address of 11 west 42nd Street, New York, New York 10036 (the "Secured Party") in favor of HL Operating Corp., a Delaware corporation having an address of 1301 West Baddour Parkway, Lebanon, Tennessee 37087 (the "Debtor").

WHEREAS, the Secured Party and Debtor are parties to a Financing Agreement dated as of July 26, 2007 (as amended, modified, supplemented and/or restated to date and from time to time, the "Loan Agreement");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Loan Agreement, Debtor executed and delivered that certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified prior to the date hereof, the "Intellectual Property Security Agreement") granting the Secured Party a security interest in certain Copyrights, Patents and Trademarks (each as defined in the Intellectual Property Security Agreement);

WHEREAS, the Intellectual Property Security Agreement was dated as of July 26, 2007, and was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("PTO") against certain Trademarks on August 2, 2007, at Reel 003593, Frame 0050 and against certain Patents on August 2, 2007, at Reel 019628, Frame 0504;

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain letter agreement dated August 1, 2012 by and among, the Secured Party, Debtor, Samsonite, LLC and Trumpet Investors, L.P. (the "Payoff Letter") all security interests and liens granted to the Secured Party by Debtor in the Copyrights, Patents and Trademarks automatically terminate upon the Secured Party's timely receipt of the payoff amount specified in the Payoff Letter; and

WHEREAS, Debtor desires written confirmation of the Secured Party's release of its security interest in the Copyrights, Patents and Trademarks for recordation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Secured Party hereby agrees as follows:

1. Definitions. Unless otherwise defined herein, all capitalized terms have the meanings provided in the Loan Agreement.
2. Confirmation of Release of Security Interest. The Secured Party hereby terminates, releases and forever discharges its security interest in the Copyrights, Patents and Trademarks, including but not limited to the Patents appearing on Exhibit A and the Trademarks appearing on Exhibit B, hereto.
