

General Instrument Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware

DOES HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name and state of incorporation or formation and the state of domicile of each of the constituent entities to the merger are as follows:

<u>Name</u>	<u>State of Incorporation/Formation</u>
(a) General Instrument Corporation ("GI")	Delaware
(b) Tut Systems, Inc. ("Tut")	Delaware

SECOND: That an Agreement of Merger has been approved, adopted, certified, executed and acknowledged by each of GI and Tut (together, the "Constituent Entities") in accordance with Section 251(c) of the Delaware General Corporation Law.

THIRD: That Tut shall be merged with and into GI, with GI being the surviving entity (the "Surviving Entity") in the merger, and the name of the Surviving Entity shall be General Instrument Corporation.

FOURTH: That the certificate of incorporation of GI at the effective time of the merger shall be the certificate of incorporation of the Surviving Entity.

FIFTH: That the merger is to become effective as of the date and time of the filing of this certificate with the Delaware Secretary of State.

SIXTH: That the executed Agreement of Merger is on file at 101 Tournament Drive, Horsham, PA 19044, the principal place of business of the Surviving Entity.

SEVENTH: That a copy of the Agreement of Merger will be furnished by the Surviving Entity on request, and without cost, to any stockholder or member, of a Constituent Entity.
