I, Megan Bombick, in my capacity as the Corporate Secretary of United States Steel Corporation, a corporation validly existing and organized under the laws of the State of Delaware (the "Corporation") hereby certify the following:

1. On December 30, 1950, Carnegie-Illinois Steel Corporation, a New Jersey corporation, changed its name to United States Steel Company;
2. On December 31, 1952, the United States Steel Company, a New Jersey corporation, a wholly owned subsidiary of United States Steel Corporation, a New Jersey corporation, was merged into said United States Steel Corporation;
3. On January 1, 1966, United States Steel Corporation, a New Jersey corporation, was merged into U. S. Steel Company, a wholly owned Delaware subsidiary. U. S. Steel Company then changed its name to United States Steel Corporation;
4. On July 9, 1986, United States Steel Corporation, a Delaware corporation, changed its name to USX Corporation, a Delaware corporation;
5. On July 2, 2001, USX Corporation, a Delaware corporation, was merged into United States Steel LLC, a Delaware limited liability, which limited liability company was the surviving entity;
6. On December 31, 2001, United States Steel LLC, was converted from a Delaware limited liability company to a Delaware corporation under the name United States Steel Corporation;
7. By virtue of said actions, in accordance with the Delaware General Corporation Law, United States Steel Corporation has succeeded to all of the rights, powers, privileges, franchises, properties, debts, liabilities and duties of Carnegie-Illinois Steel Corporation, United States Steel Company, United States Steel Corporation, U. S. Steel Company, USX Corporation and United States Steel LLC.
